- React Native is a JavaScript framework for writing real, natively rendering mobile
 applications for iOS and Android. It's based on React, JavaScript library for building user
 interfaces, but instead of targeting the browser, it targets mobile platforms. In other words:
 web developers can now write mobile applications that look and feel truly "native," all from
 the comfort of a JavaScript library. Plus, because most of the code written can be shared
 between platforms, React Native makes it easy to simultaneously develop for both Android
 and iOS.
- With an intention to make MCA Sem 3 students aware on the basics of the React Native app with CRUD operations, we conducted the workshop on React Native under the banner of SCETAA as Mr. Tosif Saiyad is SCET alumnus. This workshop will help the students in the practicals of the subject Mobile App Development with Web Integration, which is part of their Sem 3 curriculum.
