

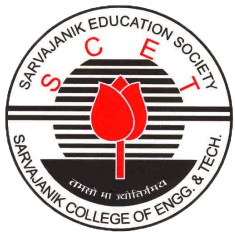

# ABOUT US



Gujarat has witnessed huge industrial growth in the last decade and hence it is imperative need to have a robust system to support student startups and innovation. Student Startup and Innovation Policy of the state of Gujarat was launched by the Education Department, Government of Gujarat. 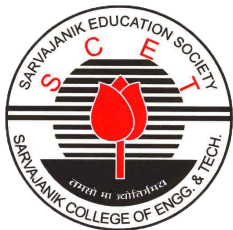

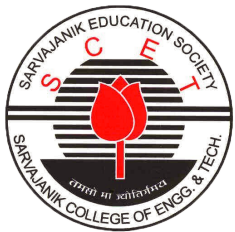
