Summary:

The SSIP committee has organized workshop on “Meet the startup founder” for all the students of our institute on 26th September, 2019. The aim of this workshop was to have students interaction with successful start-up founder, know about their journey and learn invaluable lesson from them.

The expert speaker, Mr. Arvind Saraf, Founder and CEO of Wishbook (www.wishbook.io) – Organizing the biggest traditional industry in India, delivered keynote interactive lecture, where students participated in discussions enthusiastically. Mr. Saraf holds B.Tech. Degree in Computer Science from IIT Kanpur and has pursued PhD from MIT, US. Before founding Wishbook he has worked at Google and co-founded a healthcare social business.

Mr. Saraf briefly discussed about entrepreneurship, start-ups, how to initiate the journey of start-ups and entering into its world with a spark of a 'Perfect Idea'. He emphasised on effective foundation of a start-up and discussed his own experiences about successful start-up 'Wishbook'. He carried on with explaining the importance of management and analysis of market, financial, and human resources. The session became very interactive when speaker asked students to discuss about potential start-up ideas and provided solutions to students' queries. Students enjoyed interactive discussions and listening to the speaker.
