

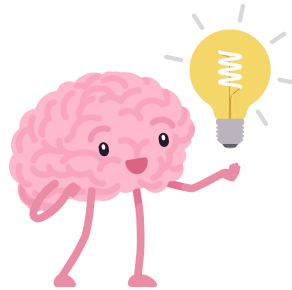



Event in Brief:

- The SSIP Idea Pitching Event at SCET was a big hit, showing off the college's creativity and talent. Out of 50 teams that signed up, 36 participated in the pitching event.
- The day was filled with exciting ideas, lively discussions, and great networking. Attendees enjoyed watching pitches, checking out prototypes, and joining interesting panel talks.
- The event was a great chance for students to connect, work together, and celebrate their innovative ideas in a fun and supportive setting.
- The ideas presented were truly impressive, covering a wide range of topics like Agroiintel (an AI system for crop recommendations and detecting adulteration), smart traffic light control for emergency services, predicting brain tumors using AI, and an Automated Threat Intelligence Platform.
- The judges were amazed by the creativity and quality of the pitches, which showcased exceptional ideas.
- The SSIP event not only encouraged innovative thinking but also set the stage for future collaboration and growth within the college community.
- 5 teams were fully accepted, while 10 teams were asked to make modifications. The teams in the "Accepted with Modifications" category presented their revised ideas on 2nd and 4th September 2024. After this additional review, 7 out of the 10 teams were accepted for the second round. In total, 12 teams have now qualified to participate in the second round of the Idea Pitching competition to be organized by Sarvajanic University (SU).
