The wheel was rotated and when arrow was pointing to any option students need to select a chit from bowl and make the guess, On right guess students were gifted with chocolates. 
- by tagline, Guess the company logo, Guess the entrepreneur, Guess the Founder, tongue twister bowls and students had to make the guess.
