International Level Swimmer

Ms. Kalyani has achieved more than 200 medals at District level, more than 150 medals at State level. She has been awarded as "**BEST SWIMMER**" in the Year 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2022 in both Junior and Senior categories in Gujarat. She has created more than 20 records at State level.

She has received the following Prestigious awards at State level

- Sardar Patel junior award Year 2016
- Sardar Patel senior award Year 2017

She is also selected for Sports Authority of Gujarat's SHAKTIDOOT SCHEME in the topmost 'A' category.

At National Level, she received 66 medals with 25 Gold, 18 Silver and 23 Bronze. She has created 2 National records in 200m Breaststroke in Under 17 and Under 19 category at School Game Nationals. She has also created 2 National Records at Khelo India University Games in 200m Butterfly and 400m Individual Medley.

She was selected for

- South Asian School Games, Palembang, Indonesia, 2016
- World School Gymnasiade, Trabzon, Turkey, 2016

She has represented India at 12th South Asian games, Guwahati, Assam, 2016 achieving 4th position. Also she has represented World School Championships, Budapest, Hungary, 2017 achieved World Ranking 10th.
