About the Event

Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) program is initiative of Ministry of Education (MoE) through MoE's Innovation Cell (MIC) in collaboration with AICTE for Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) to systematically foster the culture of innovation. With this objective Innovation Council, SCET and R&D Cell, SCET has organized an event for Institution's Innovation Day on 18th October, 2023 (3:00 pm – 5:00 pm). The event was organized for the UG students to guide and motivate them towards book reading on entrepreneurship and innovators lives. In Today's digital era, very few students having reading hobby. To motivate the students to read books on Autobiography or on life and struggles of an innovator, the cell has organized the event. Before ten days, students were communicated about this event with the example list of books they can read about.

There were two rounds during event.

- 1. Writing a compelling book review.
- 2. Sharing an incident from the book that motivated you the most.

The event was started with a Welcome address by Dr Tejal Joshi followed by the felicitation of the jury, Dr. Kaushika Pal by flower and memento. This was followed by a speech by President Dr. Utpal Pandya regarding the importance of entrepreneurship. During First round students wrote the book review for 30-40 mins. Student were given guideline about points to include while writing the book reviews. They were instructed to include book and Author's name, Genre, the pages and other relevant details before writing the review about plot and their thoughts about book after reading.

And then they all came on stage for round 2 where they all spoke about the book they read, learning outcome from the book, and they narrated a good inspiring incident from the book.
