Women's development cell (WDC), SCET organized Talk on “**Cancer Awareness (Breast cancer and Cervical cancer)**” by Dr. Ravi Raj & Dr. Tejas Jariwala on 19th November, 2019, 10:30 am to 11:30 am, at N.J. Seminar Hall, SCET.

Dr. Ravi Raj is a renowned Oncosurgeon of Gujarat and a medical director of Ratandeep Cancer and Multispeciality Hospital, Surat. He has been trained from esteemed TATA Memorial Hospital, Mumbai. He has served as chief Oncosurgeon and medical Director of Bharat Cancer Hospital and chief Oncosurgeon of SHALBY Hospital, Ahmedabad. He is one of the very few and the only qualified trained ROBOTIC surgeon of South Gujarat. He has developed a novel surgical technique for Oral Cancer for the first time in world that is known after his name as “Dr. RAVI RAJ TECHNIQUE”. This was awarded as “Best Research of the year” in 2014 by the Society of Laproscopic surgeon, USA.

Dr. Tejas Jariwala is a renowned Laproscopic surgeon and a Director of Ratandeep Cancer and Multi-Speciality Hospital, Surat. He has served as a full time general surgeon at Lokhat hospital Rampura, Yashfeen Hospital and Genesis Hospital. He started his own laparoscopy speciality hospital “Laparocare surgical hospital” at Surat.

Prof. Urvi Jariwala introduced our speakers and after floral welcome, talk by Dr. Ravi Raj was started. He started his talk with common cancer Myths and Misconceptions. In his talk he discussed the difference between normal cells & cancerous cells, its causes and symptoms. He also discussed about the signs & symptoms of Breast Cancer with examination methods like self-examination, clinical and mammography technique. Causes and preventions regarding Cervical Cancer were also discussed. The talk was ended by questions-answers and informal discussions with audience.
