




The webinar was aimed to create awareness of waste segregation/management. Innovate4India, SMC and AIC Surti ILab has come up with a unique opportunity for students to participate in **Surti Segregation** contest which focuses on pilot solutions to wastes segregatation (Geela and Sukha kachra) of surti homes. The Surti segregation challenge will inculcate the practice of waste segregation among the residents at source thereby saving 300 crore per year spent by SMC on waste processing. The main objective is to find a scalable and innovative Solution to achieve 100% segregation at source in residential areas of Surat City. A cash incentive has also been announced for rewards between 25000 and 2.5 lakhs.

The Webinar was a great experience. The webinar provided an insight in an interesting and informative session about various ways to segregate waste and importance of treating waste as a resource with an attempt of towards inculcating productivity among the students community.
