About the Event

Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) program is initiative of Ministry of Education (MoE) through MoE's Innovation Cell (MIC) in collaboration with AICTE for Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) to systematically foster the culture of innovation and entrepreneurship skills in professional. With this objective Innovation Council, SCET, SCET has organized a workshop on “Capacities Building for Professionals. The event was organized for the UG students with the objective of giving important tips for development of various attitudes and behaviour skills required in professional life. The expert of the session was Stuti Agrawal, who is a young enterprenuer/ founder of Prodigy Club and Toy Academy. Recently her startup Prodigy Club won the “Best Startup” award in a Impact Investors Summit at IIM Ahmadabad. She is a corporate Trainer also.

Design Thinking & Canvas Preparation Workshop was a comprehensive event organized on May 12-13, 2026, where first-year IC and Electrical students presented their canvases. Hosted at the Embedded Lab, IC, and Computer Lab, Electrical, the workshop was guided by Dr. Tejal Joshi and faculty coordinators Dr. Shabbir Vora, Prof. Nandkishor Joshi, and Dr. Hardik Desai. The event walked students through the core design thinking stages: Empathize, Define, Ideate, Prototype, and Test.

Dates: May 12th and 13th, 2026 Participants: First-year Instrumentation & Control (IC) and Electrical Engineering students. Venues: Embedded Lab (IC) and Computer Lab (Electrical).

The details of two day workshop is explained below in three different stages.

1. The event was **Final stage of Semester-Long Preparation** Phase Rather than learning the concepts overnight, the students underwent a sustained learning process. Throughout the semester, two hours per week were dedicated to guiding students through the Design Thinking process. During these weekly sessions, students were taught the theoretical frameworks and given step-by-step guidelines to practically prepare their canvases.
2. Application of the Design Thinking Process During their weekly hours, students applied the five stages of Design Thinking (Empathize, Define, Ideate, Prototype, and Test) to real-world problems. Following the specific guidelines provided by their faculty, they systematically built out their projects using five key frameworks: 1) Observation (AEIOU): Documenting Activities, Environments, Interactions, Objects, and Users. 2) Empathy Mapping: Charting what users say, think, do, and feel to understand their pains and gains. 3) Mind Mapping: Visually organizing their raw research data to find patterns and clear problem statements. 4) Ideation Canvas: Brainstorming and engineering ideas using divergence and convergence techniques.

- 5) Product Development Canvas: Defining the final product's functions, features, and evaluating it across technology, aesthetics, environment, cost, and ergonomics.
3. The Final Presentation (May 12-13) The semester's hard work resulted on May 12th and 13th. Having prepared their canvases according to the strict weekly guidelines, the first-year IC and Electrical students presented their completed canvases and innovative solutions to the faculty coordinators.

Outcome of the workshop:

The most immediate outcome of the May 12th and 13th event was the successful presentation of the students' semester-long projects. Each student team produced a comprehensive portfolio consisting of five completed canvases:

AEIOU Canvas: Detailed ethnographic field observations.

Empathy Map: Documented user pain points, needs, and emotional responses.

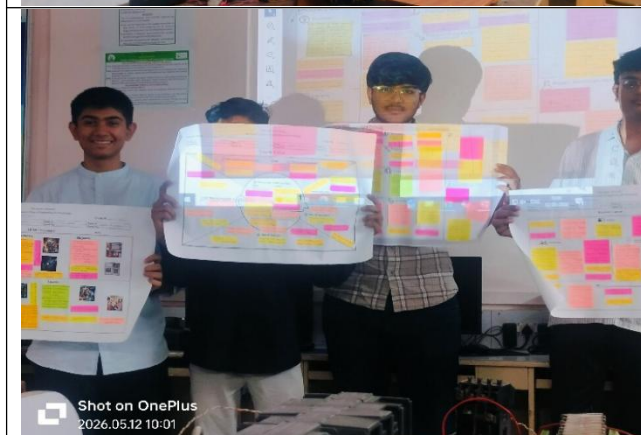
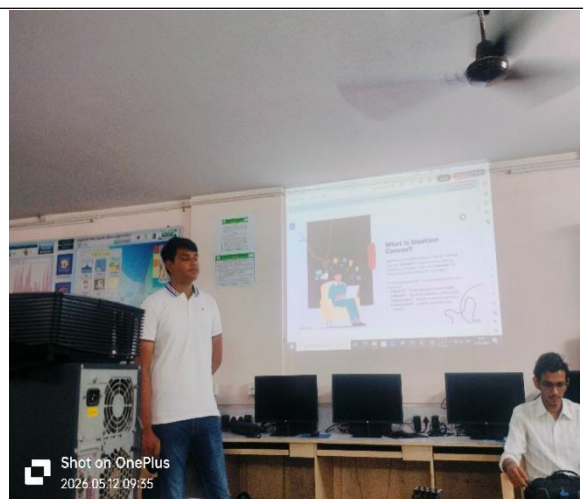
Mind Map: A visual synthesis of their research data highlighting clear problem statements.

Ideation Canvas: A collection of brainstormed, "engineered" ideas using divergent and convergent thinking.

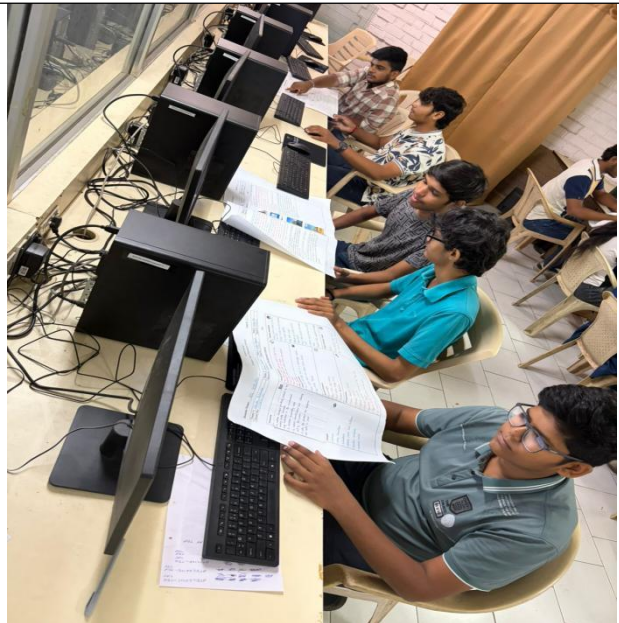
Product Development Canvas (PDC): A finalized blueprint for a proposed product, detailing its specific functions, features, and evaluation across technology, aesthetics, environment, cost, and ergonomics.

The ultimate practical outcome of the workshop was bridging the gap between an abstract idea and a physical product. By completing the Product Development Canvas, students successfully transitioned their conceptual solutions into actionable plans ready for the prototyping phase
