Applied Science and Humanities Department is one of the oldest department comprises of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Management, Humanities and Social Science. The purpose of this department is to cadre the knowledge to engineering student the basics of science and other allied subjects which helps them to learn their engineering better. Mathematics and technical communication are considered to be the core subjects for the overall development of an engineer. However, Chemistry, Physics and Management subjects are having their own importance in the curriculum in all engineering branches. Aim behind doing such technical activities is to cultivate the importance of the different allied subjects in the mind set of students along with their technical subject which they use to learn in their own departments.

With this aim, the department of Applied Science and Humanities has planned different technical events under the banner of Samanvay-22 (which itself defines the co-ordination among the different sections of ASH Department) in Kshitij-22 which is one of the oldest & most popular Techno-fest of Sarvajanik College of Engineering and Technology. Kshitij (Anant Gyaan Ki Talassh Mein) is the brand name of the techno festival organised by SCET since 2002.

Under the banner of Samanvay-2022, Humanities Section of ASH Department organised an elegant and educational event namely *Lang-Quiz*. Completely offline in nature, this team event challenged the students to test their proficiency of English Languauge. The event was coordinated by **Prof. Denish Jariwala** and **Prof. Kruti Desai** from Humanities Section, ASH Department.

Struture of the Event:

For the Language Quiz, students were supposed to participate in a group of two members. The quiz was divided into two rounds:

1. Preliminary round

<u>Date:</u> 30th September, 2022 | <u>Time:</u> 10.00 am to 10:45 am

In the preliminary round, participants appeared in a written test, wherein they answered 30 questions dealing with vocabualry, grammar and interesting facts about English language.

2. Final round

Date: 1st October, 2022 | Time: 10.00 am to 11:00 am

The final round was divided into 3 sub-rounds:

- (i) **Vocab-Hunt**: Participants were asked compelling questions regarding English words, idioms and proverbs
- (ii) Rapid-Fire Round: Questions regarding grammar and interesting facts about English language
- (iii) Audio-Visual Round: Naming the animals/objects/instruments shown in the image, identifying characters after listening famous dialogues

Number of Participants:

Buoyant response from the students of all the branches made the event a triumphant one. Total 43 teams (86 students) registered themselves for the event. As many as 48 teams i.e. 96 students (including on-the-spot registration) from different engineering branches of the college participated with immense zeal and zest. After Preliminary Round, 6 teams were selected for the final round and 3 of them turned to be the winners of the event.


