For the Language Quiz, students were supposed to participate in a group of two members. The quiz was divided into two rounds:

DAY: 1 PRELIMINARY ROUND

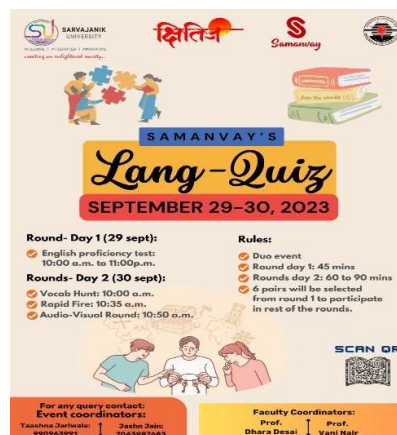
Round 2: Rapid-Fire- Name That Image!

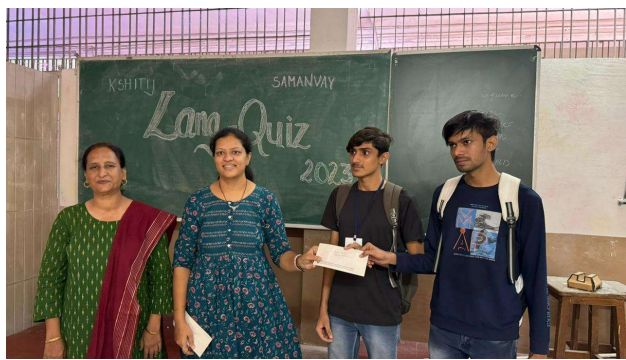

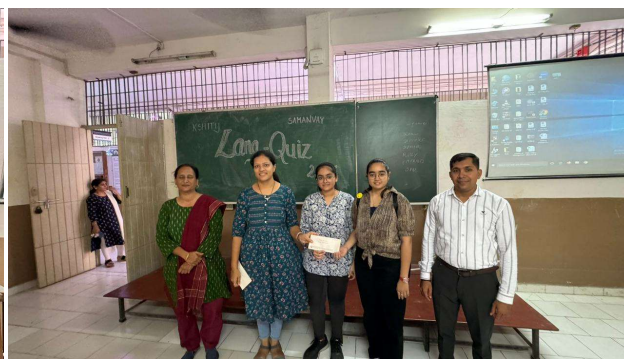

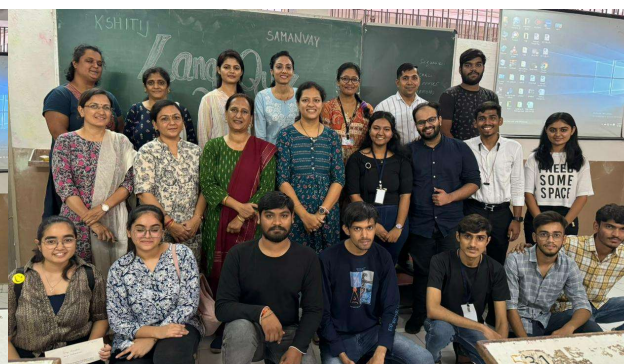
