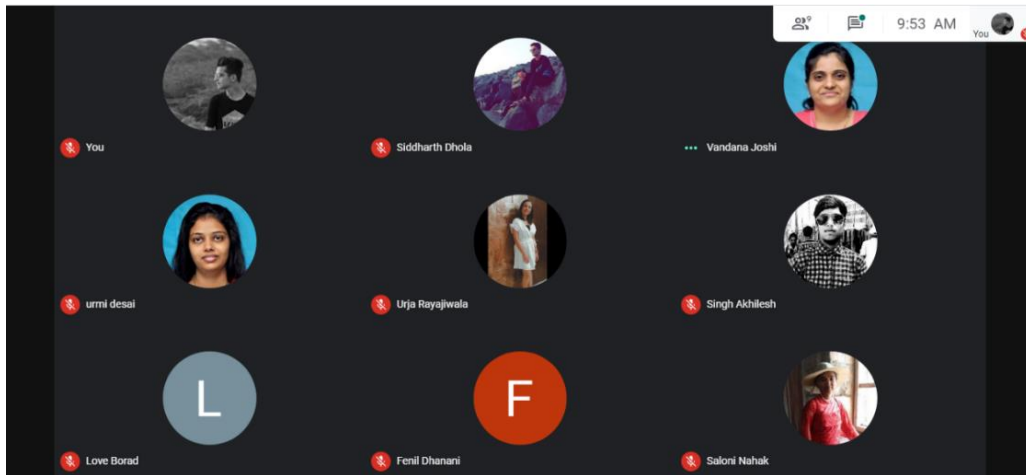

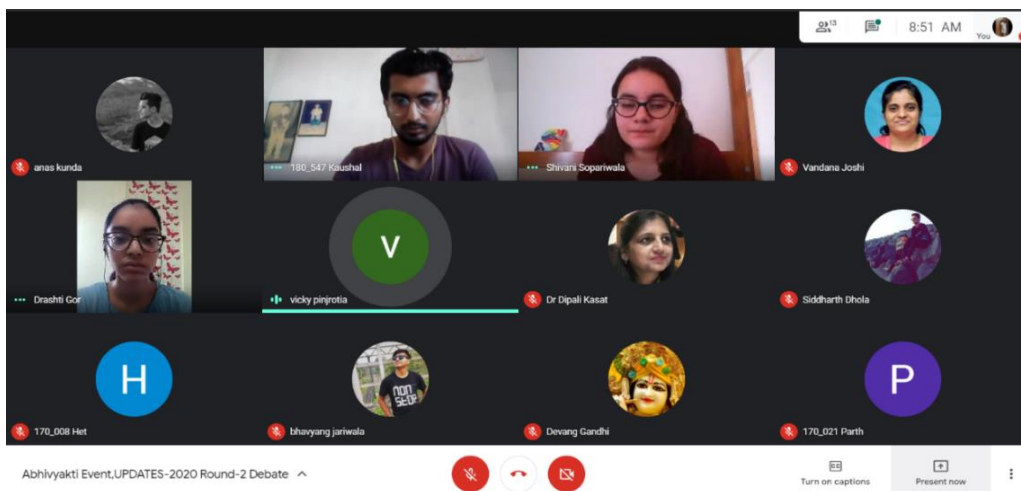
Round 3- For the third round, we organised PODCAST TALK for the finalists. Each team had showcased their podcast talk for about 10-15 min and were evaluated for it.

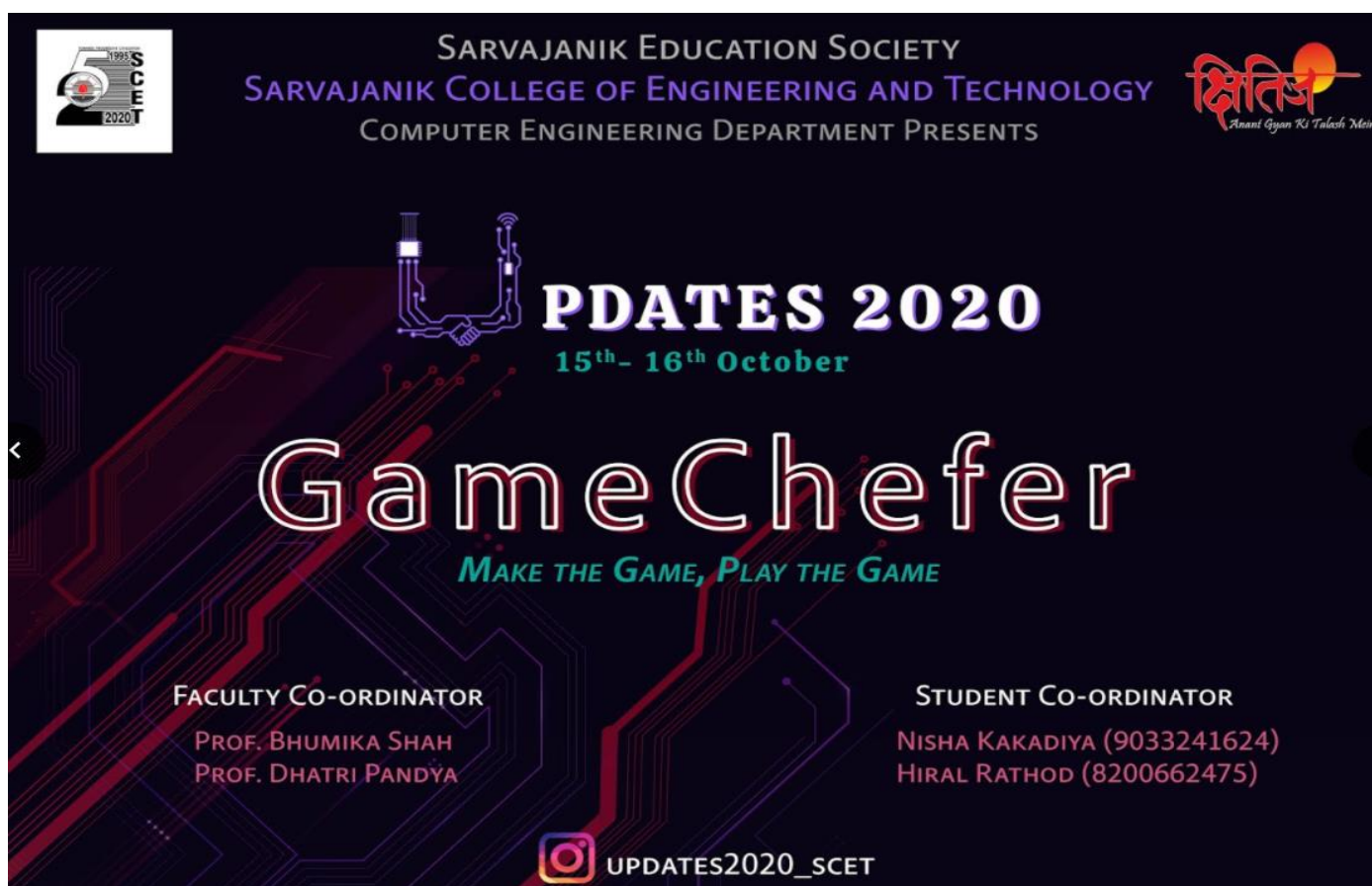

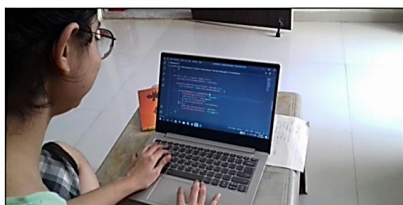

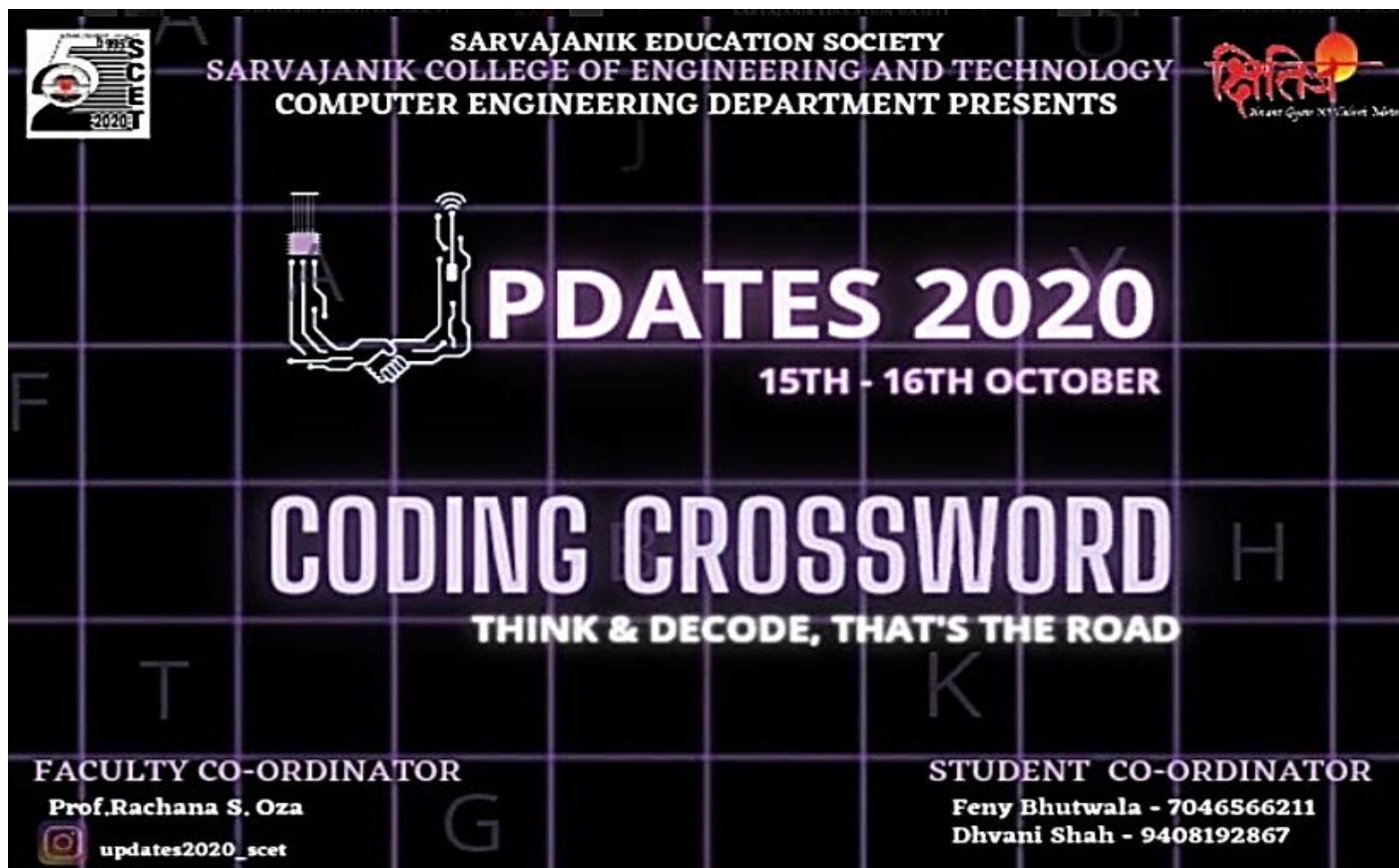

Coding Crossword was an event where you would love to solve tricky puzzles by being a coding enthusiast. There were 2 rounds in this event.

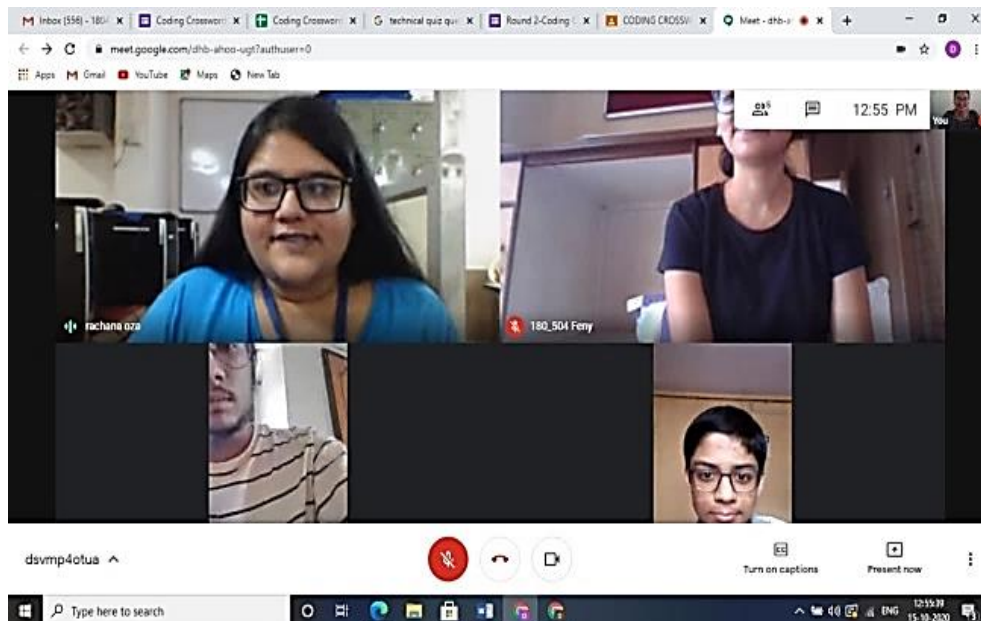
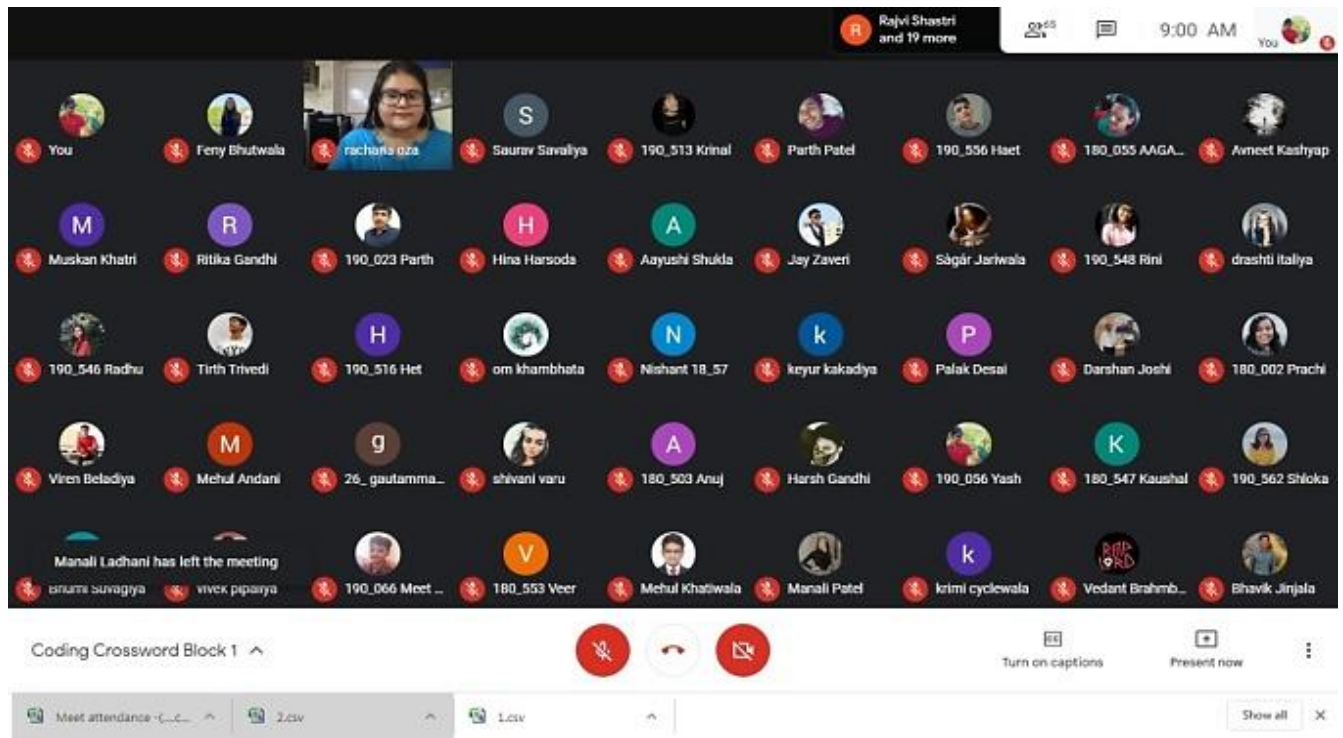
Round 1: Participants were made to solve the crossword with the clues given related to core understanding of coding concepts.

The questions are to test your logical thinking capabilities. It was a very close competition with just a gap of 10 points in between the winners. It was conducted on Hacker Earth.









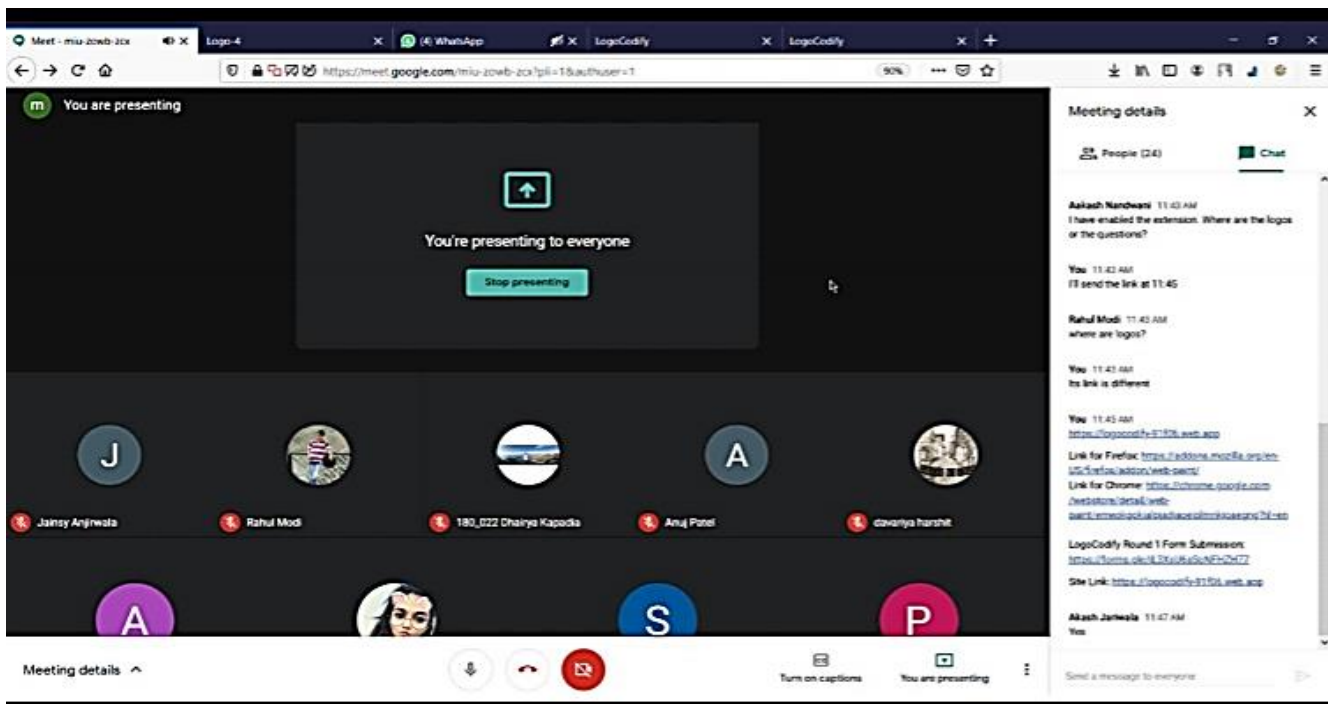
Logo Codify had two rounds:
