

ABHIVYAKTI


Abhivyakti was an event that strengthens the presentation skills. It provided students a platform to show their soft skills and knowledge on given topics. It also made them confident about themselves.

Certain topics were given beforehand and the participants had to choose from that and present it in around 10 to 12 slides their ideas and views. They were given 10 minutes to complete their topic and presentation.

MOCK PLACEMENT

Round 1- (Nous Test)

The total 54 participants appeared in the aptitude test based on mathematical, reasoning and technical competencies. The test consisted of 30 questions and 35 minutes were provided to solve those questions.

Round 2-(Round Table)

In this round, a contemporary topic was provided. Selected 10 participants from round 1 had a group discussion on a given topic. The aim of this round was to assess the thinking capability, articulating skills and communication competency of the candidate.

Round 3-(HR-Tech Confab)

5 participants that cleared round 2 were interviewed. HR and Technical Interviews were conducted separately by the experienced judges to test their crucial competencies.

Round 1- (Quizophile)

First round had quiz of basic circuit questions. 15 minutes were given for solving the questions.

Round 2- (Logic Meri Jaan)

In this round, questions were asked based on digital electronics and logic gates. 10 teams were selected for round 2.

Round 3-(Surprise Round)

This round included circuit implementation with some twist and 10 minutes were given for the same.

In this round participants were given paper with various logos on it. They had to identify and label those logos.


Round-2(Surprise Round)
