



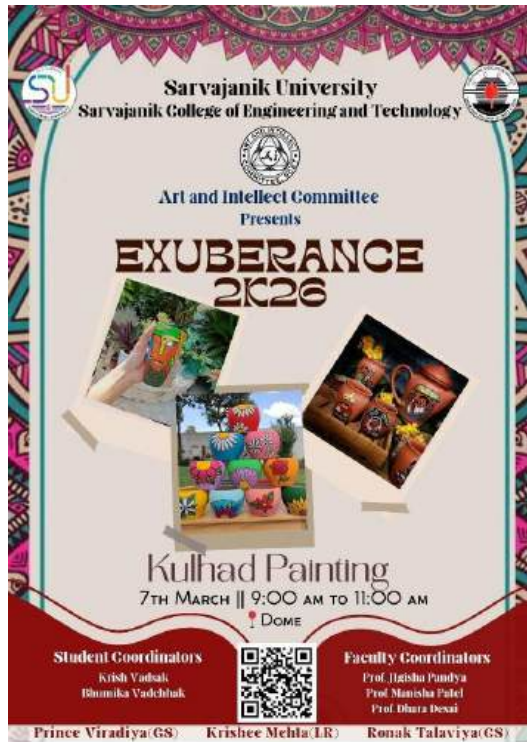




### **Event: Kulhad Painting**
