The industrial tour to Manchar-Pune started on the evening of 24th August 2023 from Surat. On 25th August we had a guided tour to the Go Cheese Plant owned by Parag Milk Food. They demonstrated the Rotolactor (German technology) where up to 20 cows step onto a rotating platform and are milked with automated pipes attached to their udders. The students were also given small shots of milk under their Pride of Cow brand.

After the lunch, the students visited the GO Cheese World, where cheese is made after the milk is extracted from the cows. The Go cheese manufacturing is one of the largest plant in Asia with the capacity of 40,000 kgs of cheese.

The evening ended with a cheese tasting session along with cheesy goodies. Students tried more than 10 different cheese varieties. All in all, a very informative trip and session.

On 26th, the students were taken for sightseeing in Lonavala. The place is good for those who do not mind walking. It is peaceful place, pollution free, with lot of trees & greenery throughout the year.

The views from various points are amazing. Lion Point is one of the most beautiful spots in Lonavala. Pawana Lake looks awesome, beautiful. Nice boating facility.
