Model United Nations (MUN) was organised for our institute's B.TECH students through the SAWC Soft Skill Development Cell. On April 19, 2023, a Model United Nations lecture was held to inform the students about the event.

The goal of conducting this lecture for students was to help them have a better knowledge of the specifics and procedures of MUN. The competitive MUN event was held on April 21, 2023. The additional objective of organising this event was to help students enhance their public speaking skills, develop diplomacy, and critical thinking abilities. Furthermore, there are other job advantages and developments available, such as standing out in the workplace, being a thinking leader, and winning over the audience. It additionally offers the opportunity for individuals to establish new social connections and become more at ease in social settings.

A total of over 40 students actively engaged in this workshop on April 19, 2023 while around 70 students showed up for the main MUN event on April 21, 2023.

Along with them, Prof. Denish Jariwala served on the event's jury.

Shivani Sopariwala and Rahul Paidra (both Computer Engineering Department students) drove on the titles of chair and vice chair.

There were roughly 24 countries allocated for the General Assembly's proceedings. Following the delegate attendance, a motion to establish the agenda was passed and the MUN officially started. All the nations present had a spirited discussion about the "Responsibility to Protect (R2P Doctrine)," a subject of immediate international importance. Additional details related to the primary theme included a contentious but wonderful conversation on the two sub agendas: balancing state sovereignty and humanitarian intervention and the responsibility to rebuild and encourage post-conflict reconciliation. The effort, research, and zeal with which the delegates boosted the discussion's spirit impressed the judges greatly. Overall, the judges felt the debate was thoughtful, competent, and well-prepared and diplomatic.

Three charters were eventually developed, and the committee approved one of them, ending the formal discussions. The judges decided, and the top delegates received awards.

These participants showed the most professionalism and in-depth knowledge of the given topics as well as a great level of understanding of international diplomacy.

In conclusion, this event helped all the participants visualize and represent something other than their person with enough confidence and maturity to be deemed appropriate for delegates representing countries.

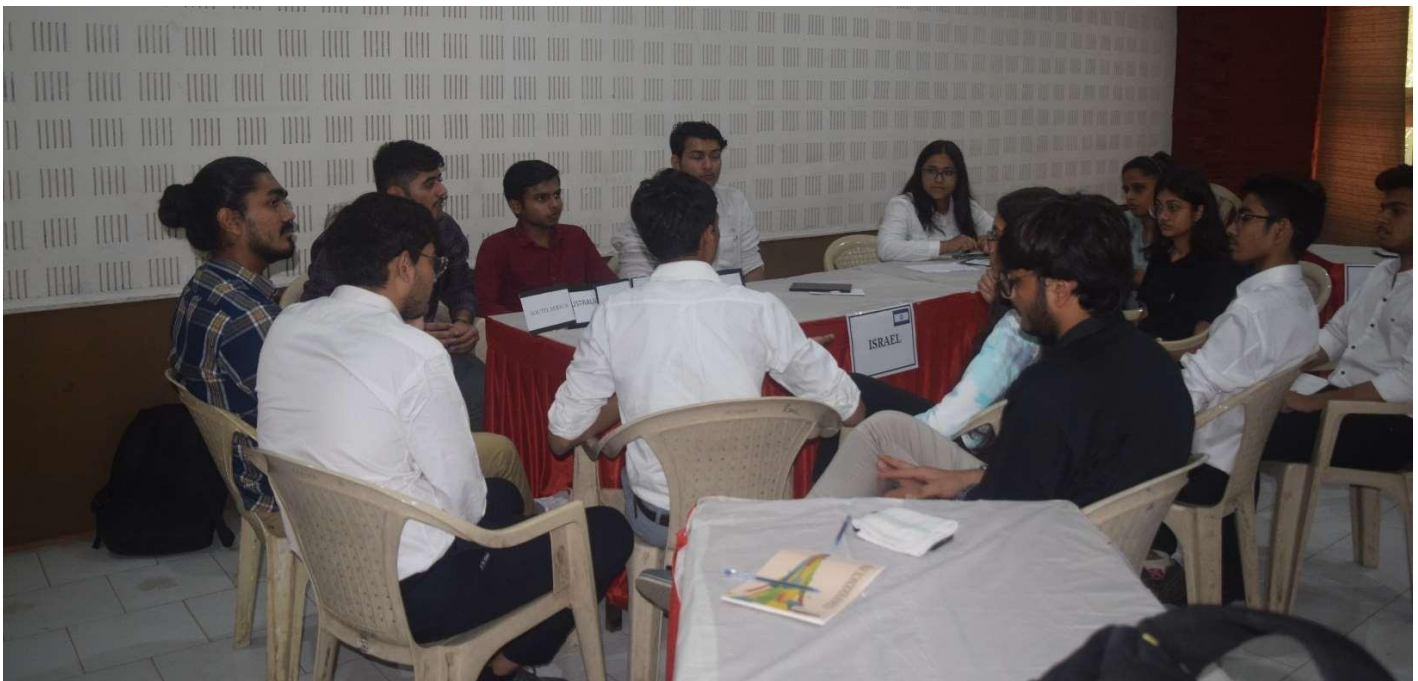
