

On August 17, 2023, the SCET National Service Scheme team has organized a "Slogan and Essay Writing Competition on Anti Ragging" at Mechanical Engineering Department, Drawing Hall and CAD Lab. Total numbers of 84 students from all the departments have participated in this event. The event was started by giving them knowledge about the effects of Ragging prevailing in youth. One video of adverse effect of Ragging on student's mental and physical health was also shown to the participants. The objective of the events are:

- 1. To aware the students of dehumanizing effect of ragging inherent in its perversity.
- 2. To inform the students regarding various laws for prohibition, prevent and punishment of ragging activities defined by the Honorable Supreme Court of India.
- 3. To eliminate the scourge of ragging including any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in unfair means or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension.
- 4. To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished.

The event was successfully handled by Student Coordinator *Mr. Tej Desai and NSS volunteers*. The duties of the Jury was done by *Prof. Sarosh Dastoor*, Assistant Professor from Electronics and Communication Department, SCET.
