Next, was Tug Of War (Team Sport). It was held at SCET Amphitheater. 4 teams participated each comprising of 8 players. 1 team won the game.

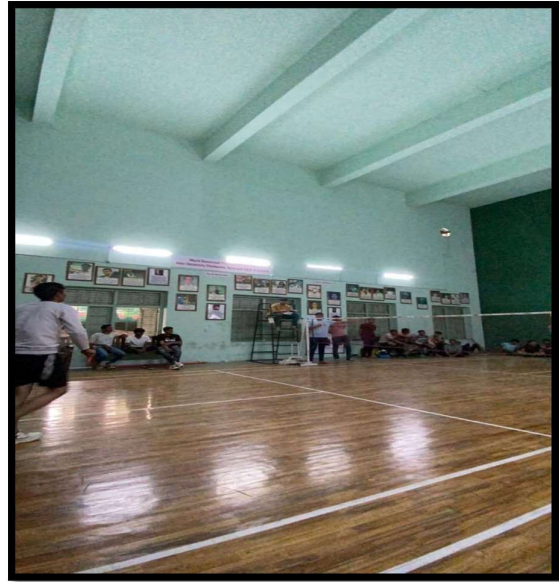
