Over 40 students actively engaged in this workshop on September 12, 2024, while around 14 people were promoted to round 2 of the debate.

The events jury included:

Dr. Vandana Shah, Dr. Sarosh Dastoor, and Dr. Dhara Desai were the jury members during the debate competition. Along with them, **Dr. Mayank Dalal** (Dean—SAWC) attended the event and supported us throughout.

There were 5 slots (each consisting of 2 teams of 8 participants) allocated for the debate's proceedings. Following the attendance, a motion to establish the agenda was passed and the Debate started. All the participants present had a spirited discussion about various topics, a subject of immediate Domestic / International importance. Additional details related to the primary theme included a contentious but wonderful conversation on these subjects. The effort, research, and zeal with which the participants boosted the discussion's spirit impressed the jury greatly. The jury felt the debate was thoughtful, competent, well-prepared, and diplomatic.

The 2 teams were eventually developed, and the jury approved one of them, ending the formal discussions. The judges decided, and the top participants received awards. These participants showed the most professionalism, in-depth knowledge of the given topics, and a great understanding of Domestic / International diplomacy.

In conclusion, this event helped all the participants visualize and represent something other than their person with enough confidence and maturity to be deemed appropriate for delegates representing countries.
