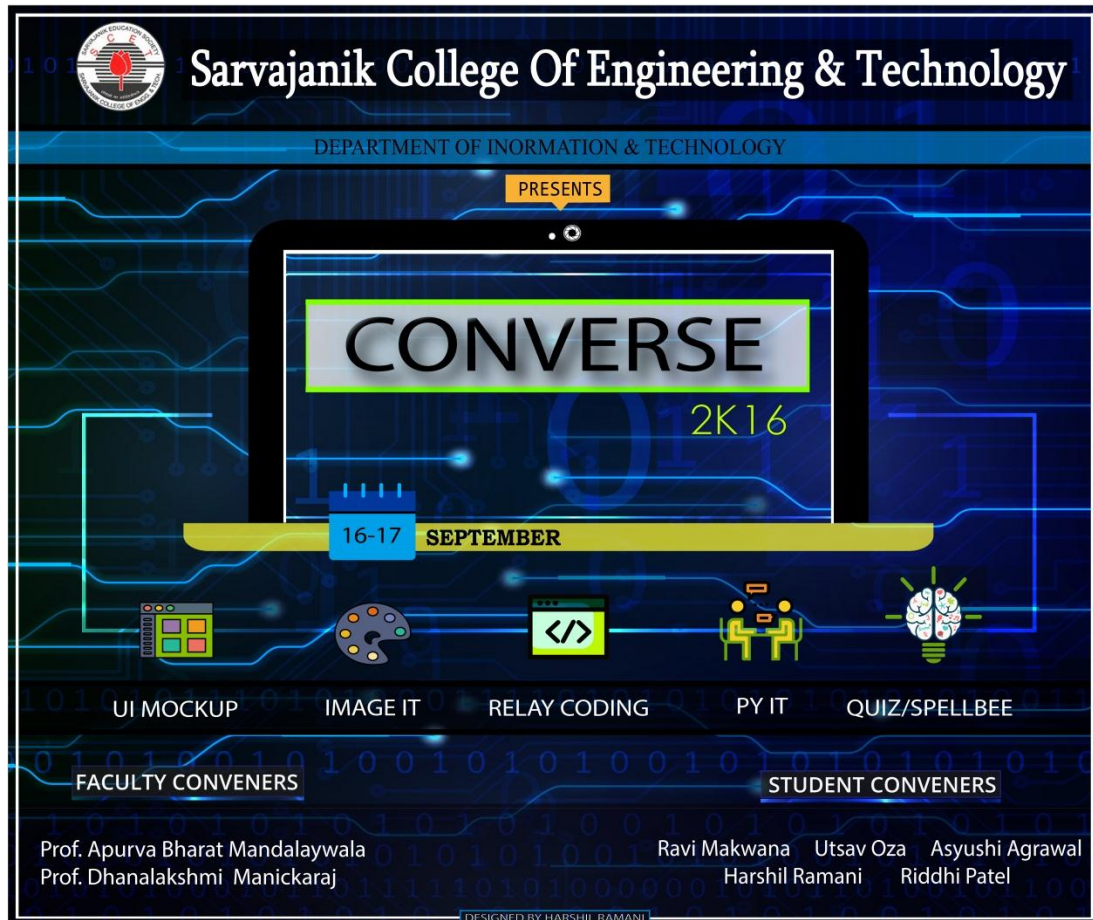


INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT

REPORT OF TECHFEST CONVERSE 2016



Information Technology department organizes “Converse” an annual interdepartmental techfest since 2008. Converse 2016 which was conducted on 16th and 17th September 2016, has received an overwhelming response from the students with 800+ participation. Converse 2k16 included the following events:

- * UI Mockup – Website making and designing competition
- * Relay Coding – C/C++ Programming Competition
- * Image IT – Poster Making Competition
- * PY IT – Practice Your Interview Test

- * GK Quiz
- * Spell Bee

The details of all the events are as follows:

UI Mockup:

The User Interface Mock Up is the event in which the students created web pages using any of their preferable platforms such as Joomla, HTML, CSS, Wordpress etc., on the topic “Indian Tourism”. The faculty heads for this event were Prof. Tushar Gohil and Prof. Bhumika Patel. There were total entries of 36 teams (2 members per team).

Relay Coding:

Relay Coding is a competition in which students were given a problem that should be solved through their programming skill in C/C++. Students participated in group of size of 2 members, in which each member has to code for 30 minutes, one after another sequentially. The faculty heads for this event were Dr. Vivaksha Jariwala and Prof. Hiren Vavaiya. There were total entries of 50 teams (2 members per team).

Image IT:

Students made a poster on given theme such as Doodle for Converse, Visualize your own universe, E-Waste, Technology In 2020. The event mainly focused on bringing out the creativity of the students. The faculty heads for this event were Prof. Jigisha Parekh and Prof. Hiral Trivedi. There were total entries of 74 teams (2 members per team).

PY-IT: Practice Your Interview Techniques

PY IT event was focused on enhancing the interview-giving skill of students. The event was coordinated to reflect the corporate interview hierarchy. The event comprised of three rounds. It started with the online aptitude test in which the questions were based on quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, data interpretation and general knowledge related to IT. The second round was group discussion in which the participants had to showcase their presentation and leadership skills. The final round was personal interview where the capability of the student was measured. Prof.

Sarosh Dastoor from EC Dept acted as external jury for the Group Discussion, and Dr. Mahesh Trivedi from ASH Dept acted as external jury for the Personal Interview round. The faculty heads for this event were Prof. Mukesh Patel and Prof. Bhumika Patel. There were total of 186 entries for PY-IT.

GK Quiz:

GK Quiz was conducted for testing the general knowledge of the students. It consists of two rounds, the first was multiple choice questions and second round was visual GK. This event received a total of 177 entries.

Spell Bee:

In Spell Bee the first round was to identify the correct spelling of the word from a set of four options while in the second round the contestants were scored on how many words they could spell correctly within one minute. This event received a total of 185 entries.

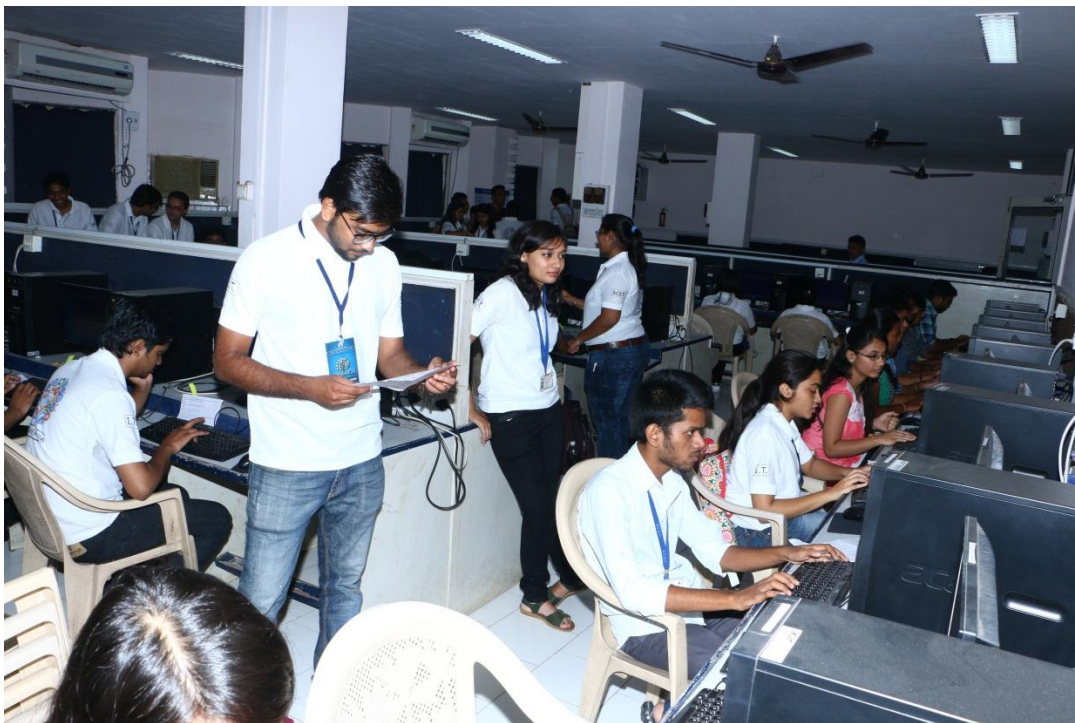
Prize Distribution/Valedictory Function:
