Inauguration of Converse 2021:

The event received phenomenal response from all student participants which made the event a successful one. This year following categories of events were conducted during Converse 2021.

- Codathon C/C++ Programming Competition
- Image IT Poster Making Competition
- PY IT Practice Your Interview Test
- IT Quiz Online Quiz of IT related MCQs
- Logo Hunt Identify the given logo is of which company

Brief sketches of all the events are described below.

1. WYSIWYG: (What You See Is What You Get)

A responsive website gives better experience to the user. So, this event was mainly conducted for the students to improve their creative skills in designing a website using software tools such as Wordpress, HTML, CSS, Visual Studio IDE etc. The themes given for designing were:

- Olympics
- Tourism
- Photography

The faculty head for this event were Prof. Tushar Gohil and Prof. Bhumika Patel. There was overall participation of 50 teams in this event.






2. Codathon:

This was a coding competition in which students were given a particular problem that should be solved through their programming skill in C/C++. Students participated in group of 2 members. First team member started coding for the given problem statement for 30 minutes. After completing first half of the coding, next team member completed the coding in next 30 minutes. If there was tie between students, then code-complexity and readability was considered as tie-breaker.

The faculty head for this event were Prof. Ashish Kharwar and Prof. Bhargavi Rani. There was overall participation of 75 teams in this event.



3. Image IT: Poster Making Competition:

In poster making competition students made colorful posters on some technical and general themes given to them. The event comprised of team of two students. Each team made posters on the below mentioned themes. Students were also given option to make posters digitally. Some teams made digital posters and some made posters on A2 size Paper sheet.

- Covid-19 awareness
- Garbage Segregation
- Online Vs. Offline Education
- Evaluation of Technology

The event was headed by Dr. Dhruti Sharma and Prof. Bhargavi Rani. There was overall participation of 30 teams in this event.





4. PY-IT: Practice Your Interview Techniques

PY IT event was focused on enhancing the interview-giving skill of students. The event comprised of three rounds. It started with an online aptitude test in which the questions were based on quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, data interpretation and general knowledge related to IT.

The second round was group discussion in which shortlisted students from first round were involved to showcase their presentation and leadership skills by expressing their view on a particular topic in a group. The final round was personal interview in which the qualified students from group discussion faced the direct interview with the interview panel of faculties, which gave them more confidence as and when they appear for interview in companies.

The faculty heads for this event were Dr. Vivaksha Jariwala, Prof. Mukesh Patel and Prof. Apurva Mandalaywala. There were total 176 entries for PY-IT.



5. IT Quiz:

This was an online quiz competition in which multiple choice questions were asked related to the field of Information Technology. The students got good opportunity to improve their knowledge related to IT sector.

The faculty heads for this event were Prof. Tushar Gohil and Prof. Komal Waykole. There were total 256 entries for IT Quiz.





6. Logo Hunt:

Logo hunt is an event where you have to identify the maximum logos correctly in stipulated time. Around 30 logos were displayed using a multimedia projector and contestants had to identify them by matching logo with corresponding names.

The faculty heads for this event were Prof. Bhumika Patel and Dr. Dhruti Sharma. There were a total of 140 entries for logo Hunt.
