Dr. Purnima Nadkarni, on an opening note extended her Teachers day Greetings and emphasized the fact that teachers play a significant role in all walks of life and that learning is a lifelong process. She spoke at length on the conventional management techniques vis-à-vis modern management techniques and their noteworthy impact on project completion & time management. She also emphasized on the "Swachchh Bharat Mission" and the need of sanitary blocks in rural areas. She later on discussed about women empowerment-issues related to the orthodox mindset of the people which leads to narrow minded thinking and biased behaviour towards girl-child-and women in society. The lecture on women empowerment also consisted of quotes from eminent personalities. She recited a beautiful poem which dealt with the subject of "Female foeticide". Dr.Purnima stressed on the topic by narrating "Each one, Teach one" and supported her narration by giving updated statistics for the same.

The entire lecture was well supported by examples of successful women from different spheres of life. The lecture ended by the audience taking an oath so as to support "Women Empowerment". The noteworthy feature of the entire talk was that all students were agog to hear from a renowned personality belonging to a diametrically different fraternity altogether and in turn Dr Purnima too kept the audience bound by her great sense of humour.
