Do you want to know how well can you do in a Placement drive. Information Technology Department is holding a virtual Placement drive, named PYIT; get the experience of it once to know how well you do. The rounds are

### **❖ Aptitude round**

Aptitude Round consists of online quiz of 30 Questions including Reasoning, Quantitative, Verbal etc. and it is going to be held one after the other on Moodle, the login ID and password would be mailed to all the PYIT participants after the registration ends. The ones, who successfully clear the aptitude round would only be given entry in the technical round.

### **❖ Technical Round**

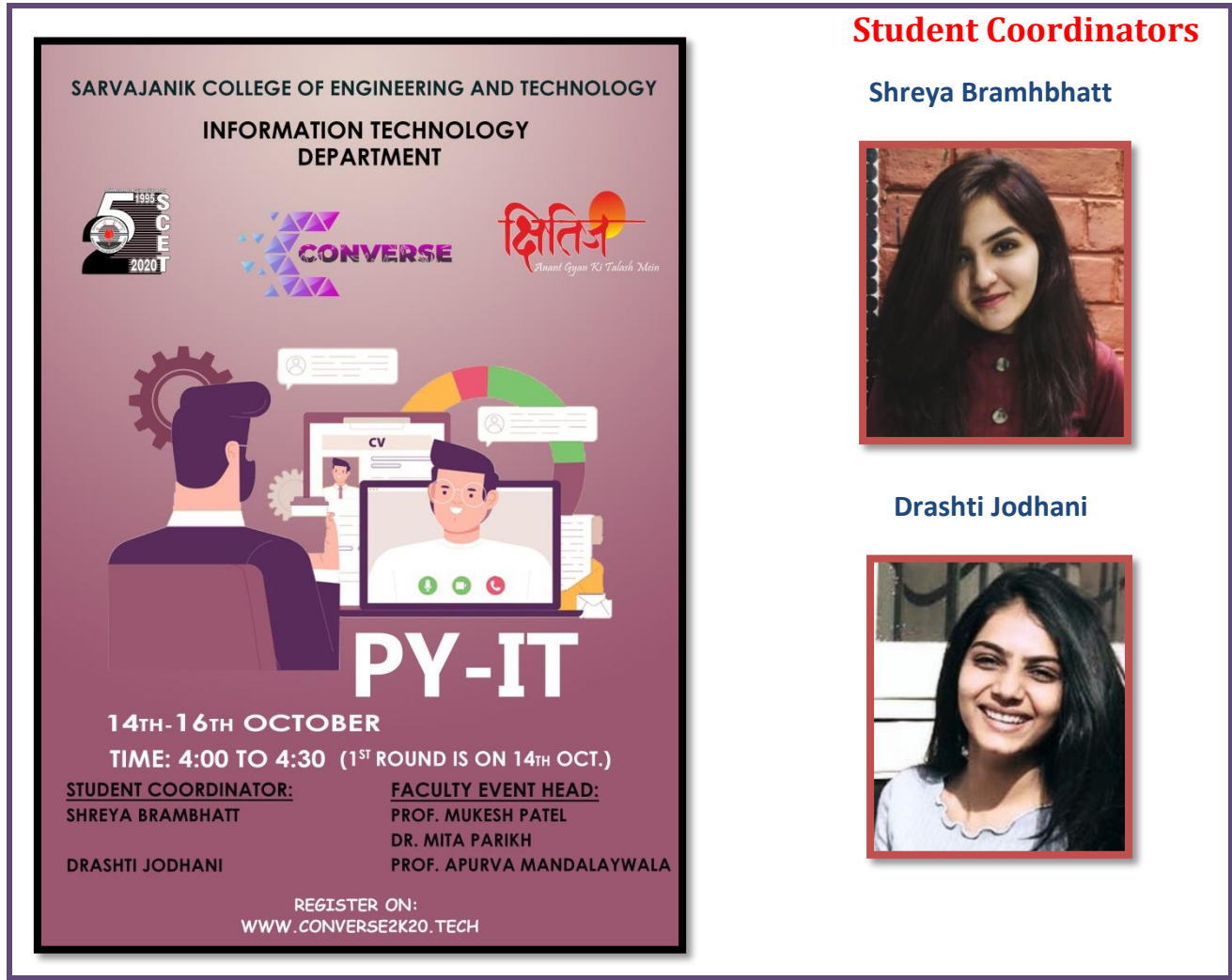
Shortlisted Candidates after Aptitude round will join the technical round where questions would be based on the basic technological knowledge in the Field of Information technology.

### **❖ Group Discussion(GD)**

Topics of Group discussion will be provided as soon as shortlisted candidates are announced. Links to Google meet would be shared to the shortlisted candidates via Mail or registered whatsapp number, and all the shortlisted candidates must log in before 10 minutes of the starting time. All the participants are supposed to sit away from the screen, in a well-lit room and their hands should be seen free of any material.

### **❖ Final Interview**

After the group discussion, 8 candidates would be shortlisted for the final interview. They will have to mail their resumes on an email address provided on the day of their group discussion at least two hours before the start of the event. The link for interview on google meet would be shared via whatsapp, and the order of interview would be pre-decided. Participants are supposed to be ready and join within 5 minutes of the link sharing. The results would be announced shortly after the interview gets over.



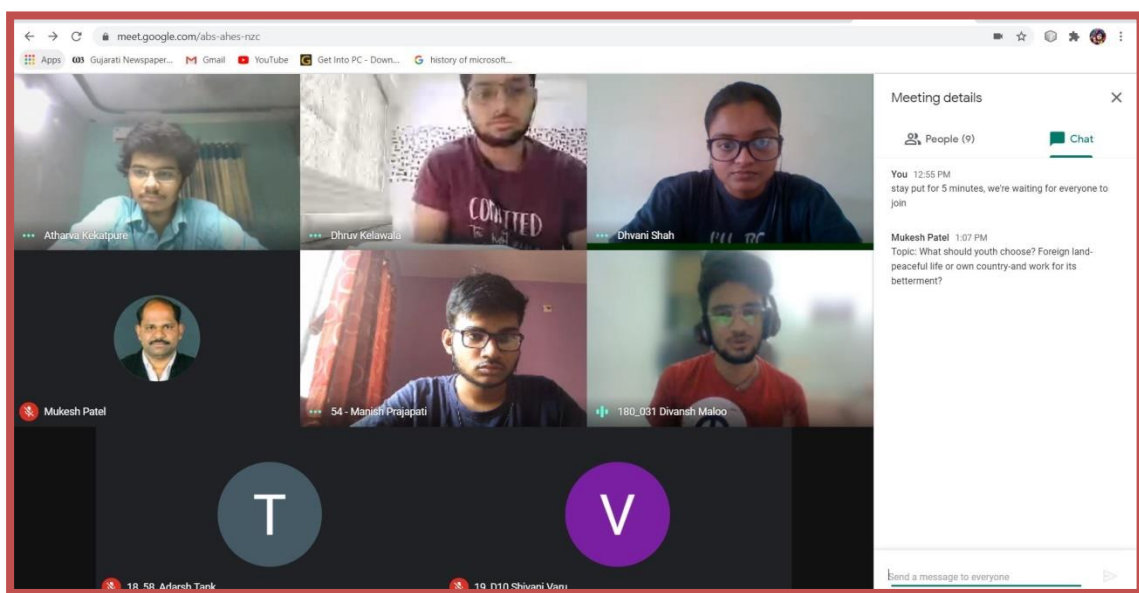
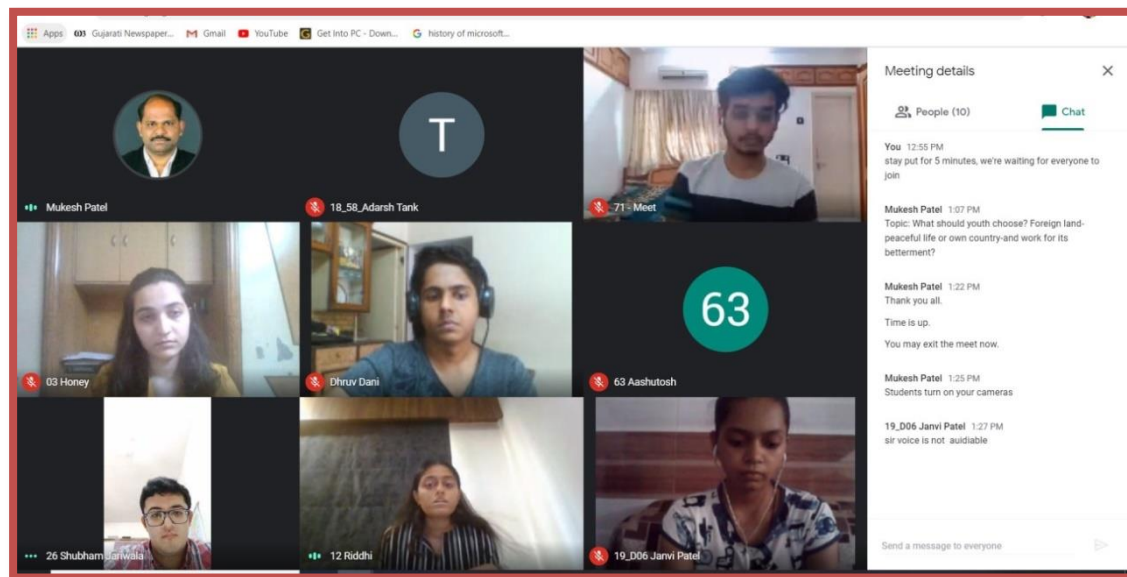

Overall number of students achieving grade ranges

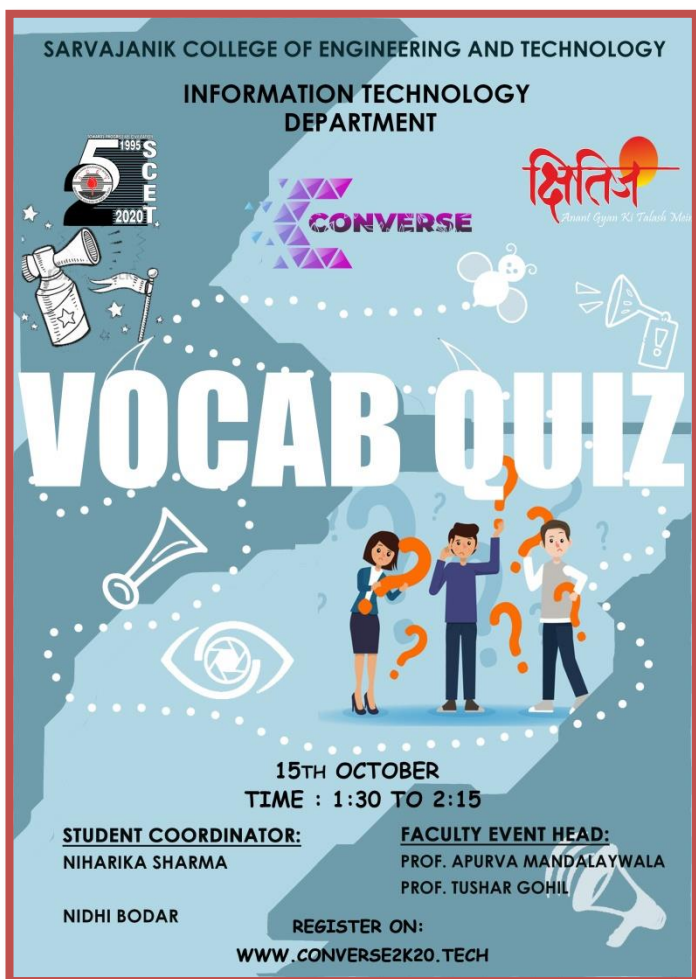

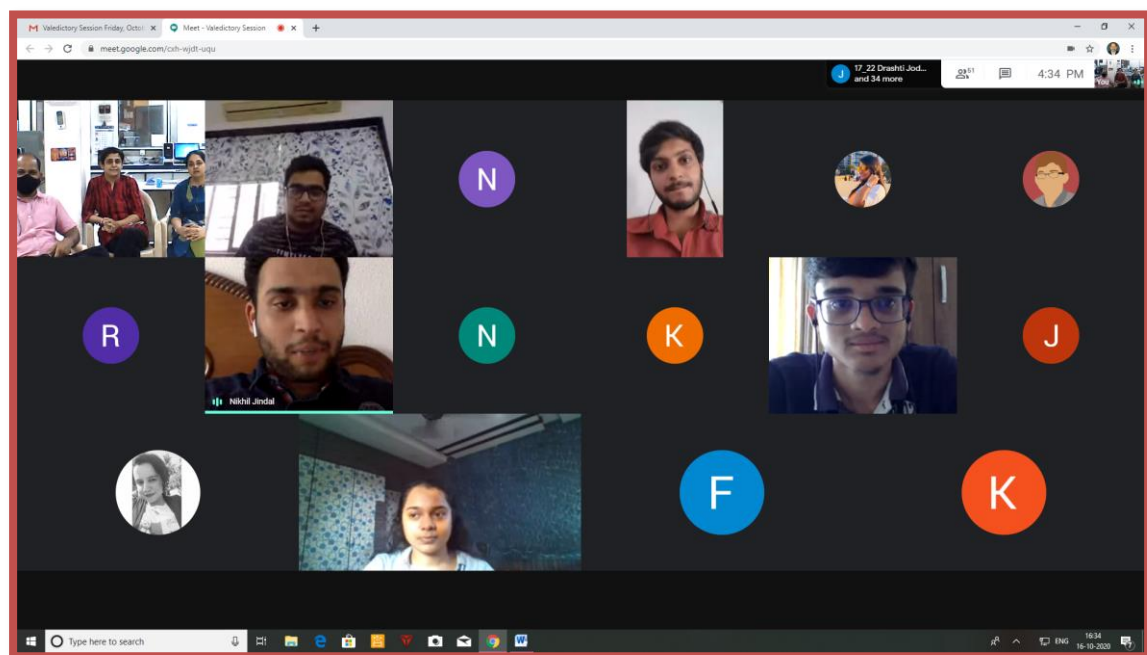
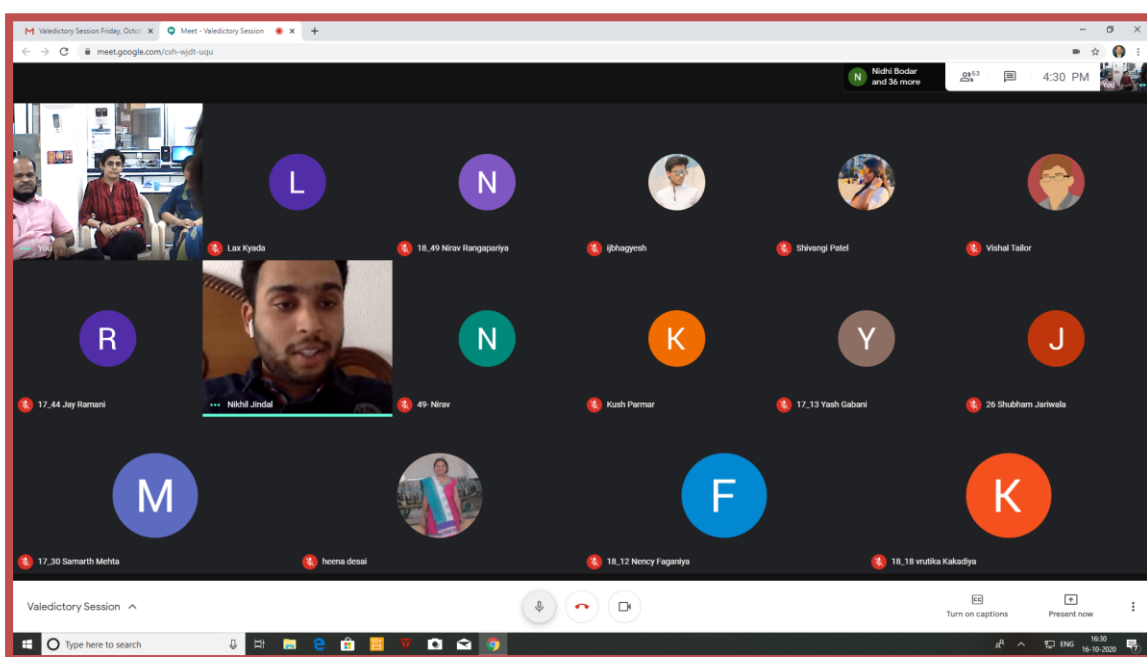




## Valedictory Session
