2. Summary

There are health conditions that can be caused or made worse by work and working environments, including stress and musculoskeletal disorders such as back pain.

The lecture series aims to provide the students with the knowledge and skills to manage Occupational safety and health, to enable them to communicate safety and health information to others. It also gives the participants the necessary information to help promote a culture of safety and health in the workplace. Furthermore, the lecture series also aims to impart the students a correct balance between production and safety.
