About the event:

The T&P Orientation program was organised with the objective of providing information related to the development of the soft-spoken skills, aptitude skills, interaction with the Industry/Company for placement and thereby, to tap out the inner dormant skills of the students. All the students of BE III sem 6 ECC participated in the program.

The talk was focussed on the internships related to the beginning of 7th Sem and that of the entire 8th Sem. The program started with the formal address of departmental T&P coordinator, Prof Sarosh Dastoor, addressing the students.

Few current final year students were invited to provide their views regarding their experience and their selection with the company. Yanshu Kikani and Manan Kevadiya of BE IV 8th Sem joined online and provided the recruitment procedure of eInfochips and shared their experience working as an intern at eInfochips. Poojan Dalal, Unnati Bachkaniwala, Dhairya Kapadiya and Ainish Nemlawala joined the program physically for motivating their juniors. Poojan Dalal and Unnati Bachkaniwla provided information about cracking TCS, competitive exams and selecting the domain of internship. Poojan also provided information regarding online coding platform, hackerrank.com for practising codes.

Prof Sarosh Dastoor presented the complete pen-picture of internships and placements opportunities in continuum with the performance as an intern. Importance about effective resume writing was also briefed. The Web pages of Placement and Internship at the departmental home page were scrolled, providing them insight and directivity about their domain of interest to work as an Intern and hence, get recruited. Prof. Niteen Patel, Dean Academics, motivated the students considering the demands of industry and skills required for the same. Prof. Nehal Shah, HoD of the department discussed about the requirements to be a fruitful engineer and highlighted them with the current trends and the demands of the companies and industries to be satisfied. She also guided briefly regarding the selection of companies and their requirements. Prof. Ketki Pathak discussed about further studies, its scope and formation of a network with the alumni for the better prospectus.

Many students discussed about the companies for internship, their requirements and selection criterions. Some were inquisitive about the future prospects and discussed individually with the T&P faculties and HoD. Few more interacted with their seniors (final year students) regarding campus placement requirements and cracking the same.

Students found themselves satisfied, after gaining the highlights of the market requirements, trends and the corresponding scope.
