The helpline, launched in collaboration with the home and women and child welfare departments, will be synchronized with the existing "1091 - Gujarat Police Helpline" and other women oriented services. The free 24x7 helpline, 181, is a toll-free number to support women in distress and is accessible through any mobile or landline. Any women can access 181 "Abhayam" helpline for the purpose of counselling, guidance, information and also for the rescue in various threatening situations including domestic violence.

Objectives of 181: To provide 24X7 free counselling, guidance and information through centralized response centre. To rescue in emergent situations like domestic or any type of violence to shift women to safe places. Response to 100% calls through technology integration.

Services to Women will be provided through:

Counselling, guidance and information through centralized response centre

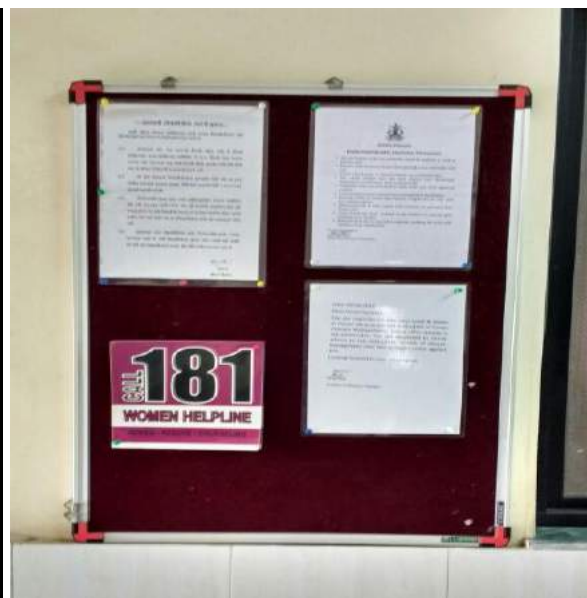
Rescue in domestic or any type of violence to shift women to safe places

Important information will be provided like local government services, women police stations, and free legal services, counselling centre, NGOs and rescue officer.

If any women will feel threatened or facing any violence she will be transferred to the nearest safe place for which she can call any time.

Women security is very important and essential in today's society. Hence awareness about the different laws implemented for women security must be spread to various classes of women in our surroundings.

This was taken as a prime priority by the NSS volunteers of SCET. Awareness about 181 Abhiyan was started by the women NSS volunteers in the different **girls' hostels in Surat like P.T. science college, Vanita Vishram College etc from 24 July 2017**. The inmates of the hostel were educated regarding the helpline no. and how it can help someone in need. **Helpline Number posters and stickers were put up at different points at the hostels**. It was a very important step in **making the women of Surat more aware about their rights and security** provided to them by the government. Hence, it was a yet another successful venture carried out by the NSS volunteers of SCET.





Goods and Service Tax Awareness

Goods and Services tax (GST) issue has been debated since from its Implementation. Some of the individuals support the implementation of GST, some still oppose to it. The main possible reasons for Indian or the consumers unwilling to support or opposed the implementation of GST because of the fear of price hike. Majority of the respondents believed that GST would causes higher inflation. In addition, lack of information and unclear about the purpose of GST implementation, Consumers are too worried.

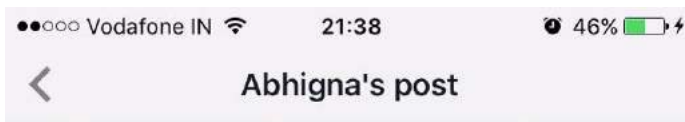

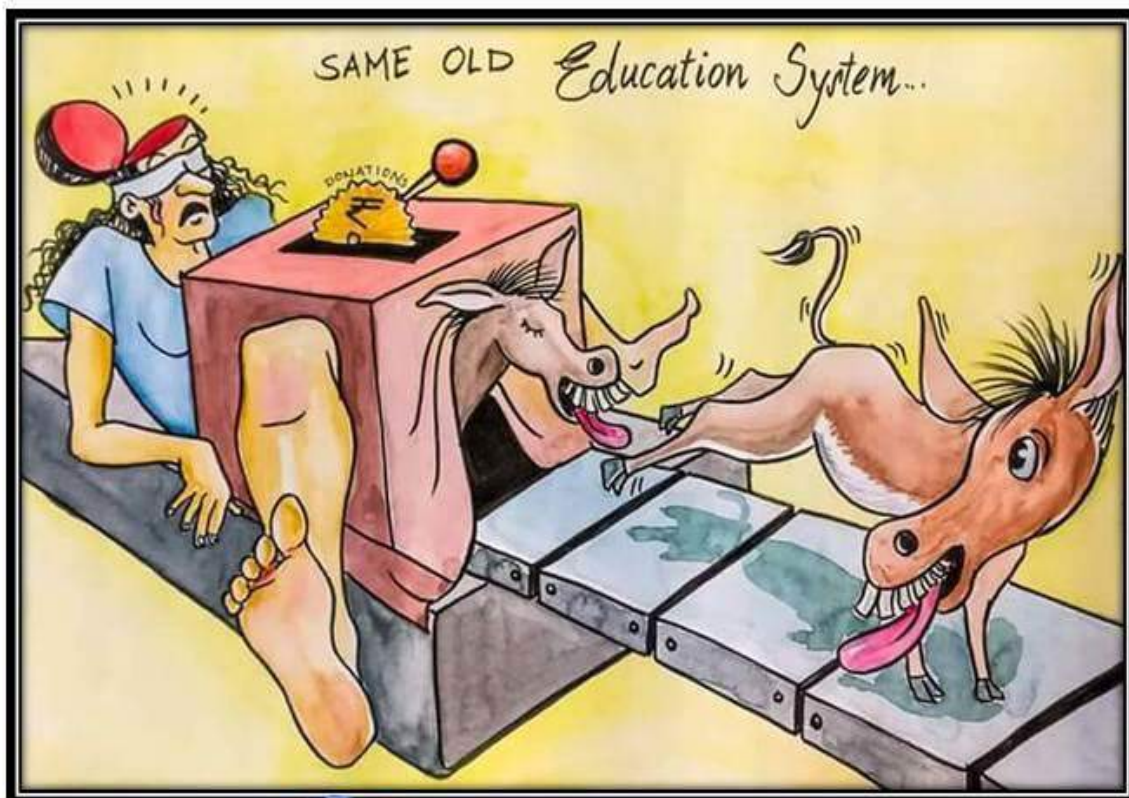

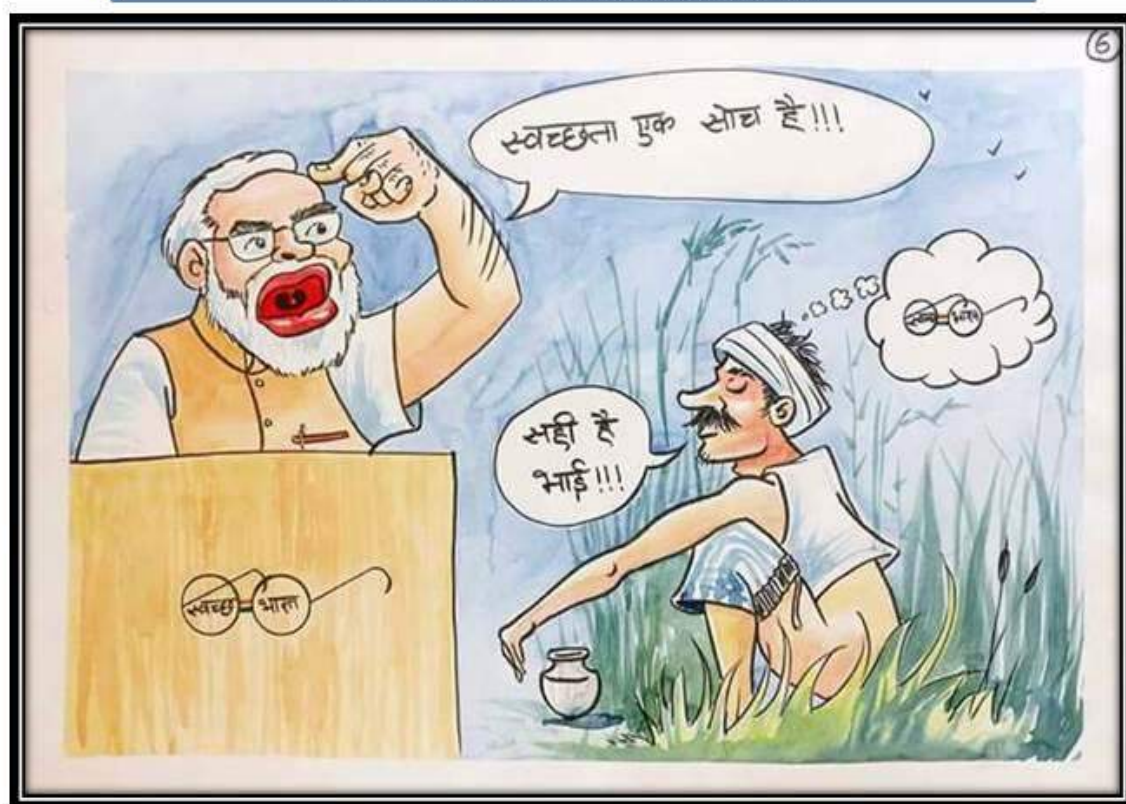

Interactive Session on “Stress Management”
For 1st year students
As a part of “Celebration of Adolescent Week”
In association with (Surat Paediatric Association)

“Our health is our greatest treasure”. Taking care of our health is utmost important for everyone. Stress is anything that alters your natural balance. When stress is present, your body and your mind must attend to it in order to return you to balance. Your body reacts to stress by releasing hormones that help you cope with the situation. That in turn takes energy away from the other functions of your brain, like concentrating, or taking action. There are two different sources of stress: **external triggers**, like getting a poor grade or breaking up with your girlfriend/boyfriend, and **internal triggers**, like placing high expectations on yourself. The American Psychological Association (APA) recently released its report about stress in students. This year the report highlighted the stress experienced by youth (teens ages 13-17) stating "high stress and ineffective coping mechanisms appear to be ingrained in our culture".

NSS unit of SCET organised an interactive session on “Stress Management” for adolescent students (1st year of BE) in association with Surat Paediatric Association (SPA) on 17th November 2017. The team of Paediatrician and Psychiatrists interacted with students. **Dr Sushma Desai** (President of Surat Paediatric Association) explained about what stress is and what are the root cause of stress in youth or teen. **Dr Trupti Patel** (Psychiatrist) discussed and demonstrated the ways to cop up with the stress. Students enthusiastically attended the interactive session.





In future the NSS unit of SCET will organize series of such session on various aspects like “Adolescent **Empowerment, Education about Healthy Family, Emotional Education, Self Defense, SMS (Sexual Abuse, Media& Substance abuse)** with such organizations for health and welfare awareness for all the students and staff of our college.

A Report on Industrial Visit to Spectrum Dyes and Chemical Pvt. Ltd

In order to broaden the outlook of students with the exposure of different workforces and to make them aware about the Industry practices and regulations, an industrial visit to Spectrum Dyes & Chemicals Pvt. Ltd, Palsana, Surat was organized by the Applied Science and Humanities and Chemical Department under the head of students welfare activity committee (SAWC). Such visits aid the aspiring engineers to bridge the gap between theoretical learning in the classroom and practical training in a real-life environment. Moreover, they provide an insight into the unit operations and various enterprises of Chemical Engineering.

The visit were commissioned on 24/02/2018 and 25/02/2018. A total of 65 students of BE-IInd semester- 4 of chemical Engineering gained an opportunity to visit Spectrum Dyes & Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. The students were accompanied by faculty members Dr. Mahesh H. Trivedi, Dr. Hitesh Desai, Prof. Ashish Parmar, Prof. Rashmita Patel and Prof. Mazhar Multani.

Key takeaways from the Industrial Visit:

1. Students visited the plant of Spectrum Dyes & Chemicals Pvt. Ltd, wherein they were familiarized with all the unit operations and unit processes
2. Students gained an opportunity to observe the whole process of dye formation from extracting the particles from chemicals to the packing for transportation
3. Students visited different labs and became acquainted with the modern machinery and got the knowledge about various operations performed at the labs
4. Students were also taken to visit the raw material storage area and the cooling room

Brief Description of the Industrial Report:

We reached the Spectrum Dyes and Chemical Pvt. Ltd at 24/02/2018 and 25/02/2018 between 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm on both days. As soon as we entered the premises, we were informed about the safety precautions one should take care of at a chemical plant and were given aprons and safety helmets.

We started our journey with beholding the storage area where solid and liquid materials were stored. Flammable substances were kept close to doors in order to gain control over fire or any other accident. Then we visited the Spectrum Labs, which comprises Analytical, Quality Control and Application Laboratories. Different operations are performed over here such as finding a new chemical for dye, finding a new dye, making dye with new methods, checking the strength of colour on polyester cloths, checking the proper dispersion of colour, separating different dyes from impurity or from other dyes using gas chromatography techniques and liquid chromatography techniques using highly accurate machines. To check different parameters of dyes, various techniques are used such as spectrophotometer, UV radiation and the like.

Then after, we took a visit of the pilot plant of the industry, which rendered a complete idea of all the unit operations and unit processes at one place. First we visited plant-1, wherein raw materials are amalgamated in storage tanks and wet cake is made. The top floor of the plant comprises a number of huge mixing vessels of different types and capacity, where raw materials are mixed in fixed proportion, at fixed temperature and pressure conditions to create different types of dye. The vessel is cleansed thoroughly, if different dyes are made one after another in the same vessel. We also gained a chance to observe the entire process of dye-formation. We saw that hydrogen chloride, amines and water were compounded to prepare Diazo, which was continuously stirred and was cooled with ice. The solution was mixed with coupler solution in other vessel to form fine dye particles. Then extra-water was removed to create wet cake, which was then transferred to plant-2, wherein it was converted into smaller size particles and were dried then.

In plant-2, wet cake was transferred into sand mill, where smaller particles (up to 2 microns in size) were created with the addition of water and with continuous motions of blades. Then the mixture was poured into a drying machine, wherein sprayed on the hot wall of vessel, the water got evaporated due to inside high temperature. Finally the dry dye was extracted and was directly sent for packing. Dyes were packed in two ways: they were bag packed, if the dye was to be transported in India or else they were packed in containers if to be transported to other countries.

We also visited the cooling room, which is very much peculiar in Spectrum. When the reaction is exothermic the ice is obtained and transferred to different station for cooling. The ice is obtained from water with the help of ammonia as coolant and then is transported around vessels with the help of fully computerized system. As soon as the amount of ice and the location in need is entered, ice will be directly transported to the desired location with the help of different types of pumps. Here, three types of pumps i.e. main pump, diesel pump, jockey pump are used, which are operated at different level of pressure.

The students also visited the waste water treatment plant. The water purification process is divided into three steps. In the primary process, lime stone or other chemicals are introduced in the water to control the pH, other soluble impurities and the COD of the solution. In the secondary process, by the means of bacteria and other chemicals, BOD is controlled removing other major impurities. Finally, waste water was treated with the tertiary treatment after transporting it to other effluent plant.

The visit made us knowledgeable about various aspects of chemical engineering and familiarized us with several significant unit operations and processes.





A Report of a Talk on “Basic Photography Concepts”

“A great photograph is a full expression of what one feels about what is being photographed in the deepest sense and is, thereby, a true expression of what one feels about life in its entirety.” Photography as an ever changing set of technical, conceptual and aesthetic conditions that exist within a broad social and cultural context.

The aspiration of SCET PHOTOGRAPHY CLUB (SPC) is to expertise, discover and unveil a photography talent within engineering students. With such a desire, SPC has organized a Talk on ‘**Basic Photography Concepts**’ by Apoorv Parikh and Sameep Dalal, Students of 4th year Chemical engineering and core team members of SPC. Both the students have a vast technical knowledge on various forms of photography.

INSIGHT:

▮ Apoorv and Sameep started the talk by explaining the basic functionalities of Digital Single-Lens Reflex (DSLR) Camera. Various lenses like Prime, Tele, Macro and Zoom were exhibited.

▮ They guided the students on basic DSLR camera modes, shutter speed, aperture, ISO, rule of one third, leading lines and many more technical matters.

▮ Various types of photography like Landscape, Portrait, Close-up, Steel Wool, Zoom Burst, Startrail, Levitation, Panning, etc. were discussed with the relevant images and their technical details.

▮ Practical demonstration of many camera settings along with various types of photography techniques was given. The camera application settings of Pro Mobile phones were discussed practically.

▮ The talk was followed by a productive interaction session with students. Lastly, a practical session was conducted for the interested students to try their hands on various photography techniques using DSLR cameras.

Steel Wool Photography uses long exposures to capture the motion of hot embers flying through the air through the act of spinning burning steel wool. To photograph spinning steel wool, a dark location is required to allow for a long exposure time.

INSIGHT:

- ▮ The students’ team has started the workshop by giving the details of Steel Wool, how it is used in photography and various techniques to perform it.
- ▮ Further, the technical details like white balance options and how to set a focus were explained.
- ▮ The important DSLR and mobile camera settings to capture steel wool images were discussed in detail. Participants then were instructed to set their cameras on appropriate positions using tripods or steady stands.
- ▮ Various frames were captured using steel wool like, circle, two circles, frames with umbrellas, with light ball, infinity shape, multiple rings, etc. 14 different frames were captured.
- ▮ The SPC students’ team was on the field to help all the participants to capture the frames in the best possible way. Participants enjoyed clicking in this unique and different type of photography workshop.

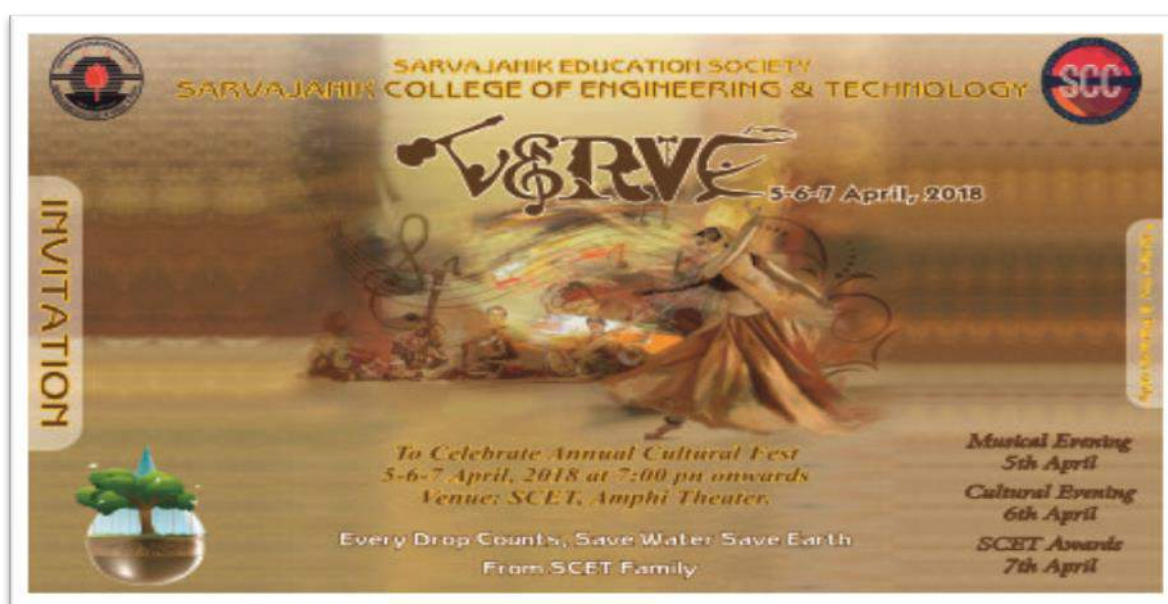
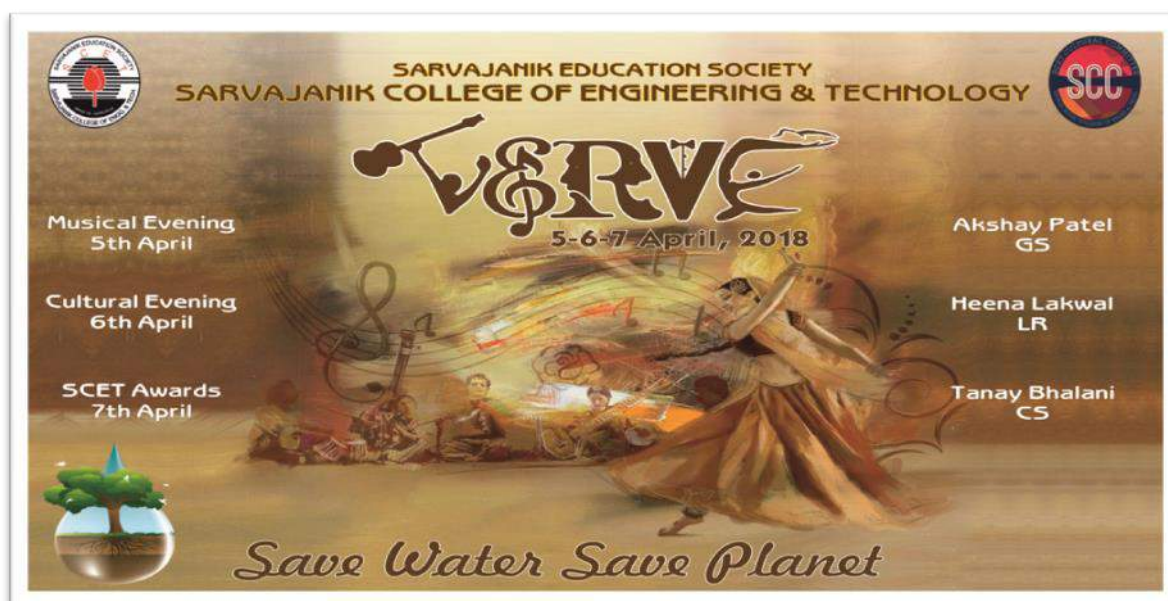

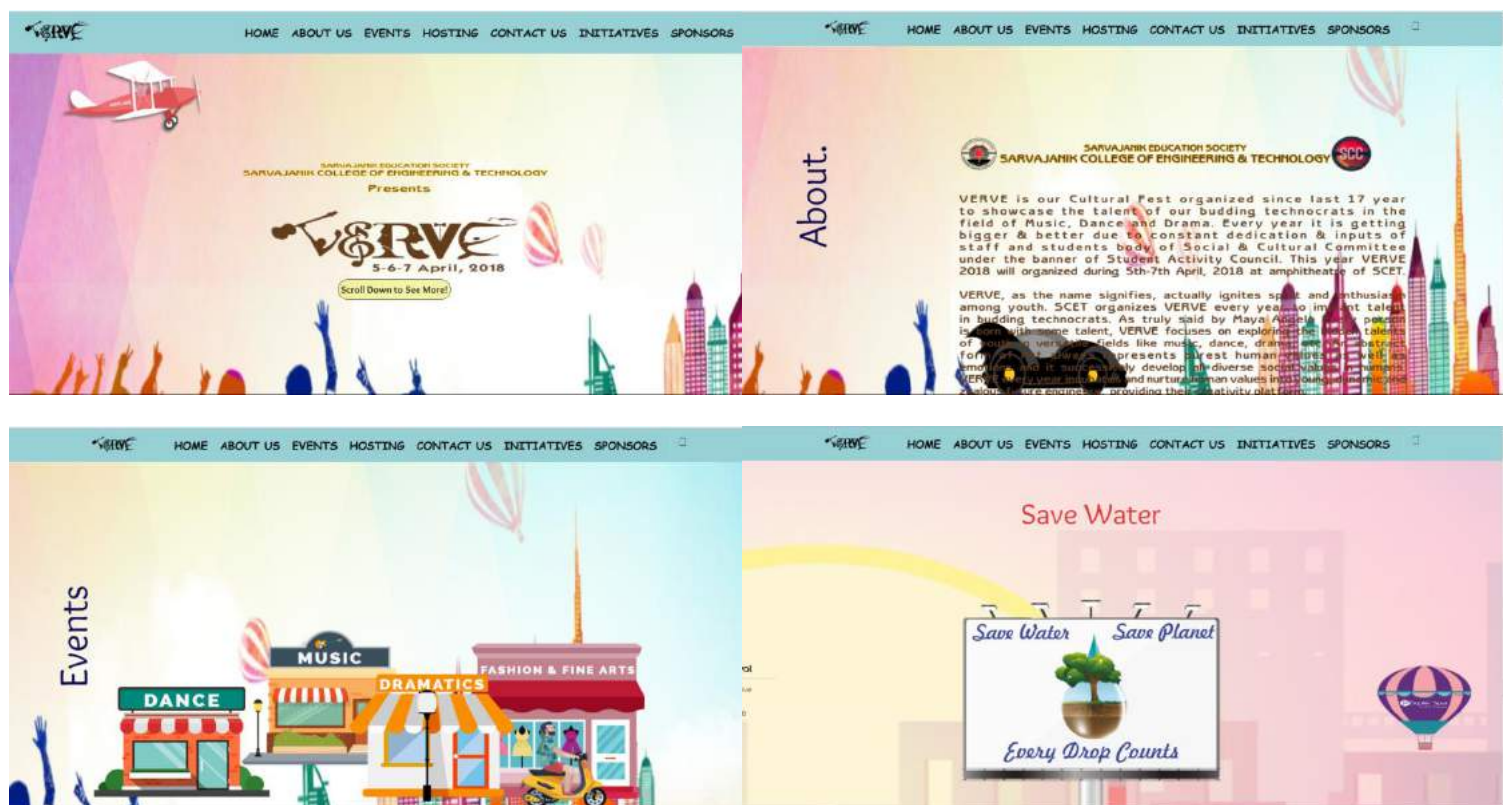
