 Operation to the students.
- He also explained placement of non contact type proximity sensor in various Machines and in complex situations using P&ID diagram.
- He also explained the life as a maintenance Engineer and the challenges they face in daily life.
- He gave some Resume writing tips to the students.
- He suggested the students to make a dairy or separate book on interview questions which were not known during interview and to follow this throughout their life and not to be disappointed by giving interviews.
