

Introduction

Department of Information Technology of Sarvajanik College of Engineering and Technology organized 4-Day Self-paced Online workshop on "Moodle Basics" during 28-31 May 2020. The workshop was aimed to guide the individuals to use the Moodle learning platform for teaching, whether it be in a school, a university, a company or just personal interest.

About Participants

The workshop was well attended. There were **74 participants** in the workshop while the workshop was planned only for 30 participants. All the participants are esteemed faculty members of Sarvajanik College of Engineering and Technology. Majority of them have teaching experience of more than 20 years.

The Lead Trainer for the workshop was **Prof. Tushar Gohil** (Assistant Professor, Information Technology Department). Prof. Tushar Gohil was also accompanied by two volunteers namely **Prof. Vandana Joshi** (Assistant Professor, Computer Engineering Department) and **Ms. Tejal Surati** (Master of Computer Applications Department).

The workshop was formally inaugurated by **Dr. Vivaksha Jariwala**, Head of the Information Technology Department.

Time Schedule:

The Four day Self-paced Online workshop was conducted on four consecutive days as per the following schedule:

Day 1 (28 May): Getting started

- Course set up
- Adding documents

Day 2 (29 May): Getting involved

- Tracking progress
- · Adding course materials, images and media
- Engaging learners in collaborative activities

Day 3 (30 May): Assessing & Evaluating

- Enrolling learners
- Setting assignments
- Assessing with quizzes
- Viewing the gradebook

Day 4 (31 May): Delivering Online Lectures, Feedback and e-Certificate

- Exploring BigBlueButton
- Sharing Your Experinces
- Generating E-Certificate

Training goal

The main objective behind the workshop on Moodle Basics is to let the participants learn the various features of Moodle, The World's Most Popular Learning Management System.

Training Procedures – In brief

Each Participant learned how to use the basics of Moodle as a course teacher. They do not learn site administration, hosting or any technical issues.

They were be a student in the course called Moodle Basics. When they first join, they can choose whether to:

- See the whole course content at once if they wish to work quickly.
- Have the course content revealed to them one day at a time if they fear information overload.

They were also be able to request a practice course where they had a teacher role and tried out activities as they learn about them.

Each day had one or more "books" (a Moodle term) which contained videos and text explaining different aspects of Moodle. Each day they tried out in their practice course what they learned in the daily "books".

On the main course page there were checkboxes against some activities. To complete the course, all those checkboxes must have ticks/checkmarks in them. The boxes with a dotted line display ticks automatically when you complete the required activity. The boxes with a sold line require you to manually tick them once you have read the information. Click into the activity, read the information and then tick the box.

Closing of the Training

In the course participant had earned two badges and one certificate.


Badges

- A completer badge is awarded to anyone who completes all required activities.


Certificate
