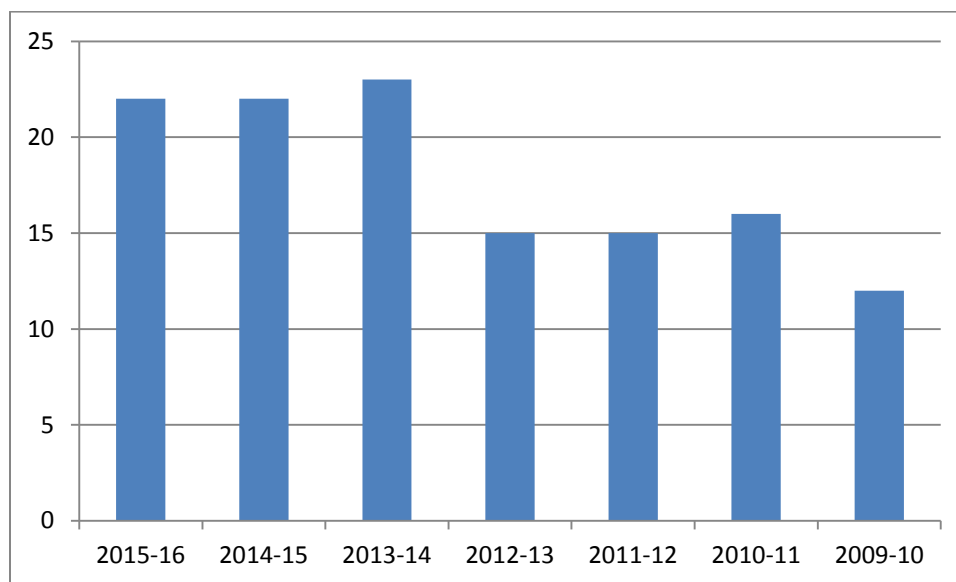
+ Brief Report of Exuberance 2016

- The students learnt the art of cartooning and made several cartoons which were put on display in the reading hall during Rangoli competition.

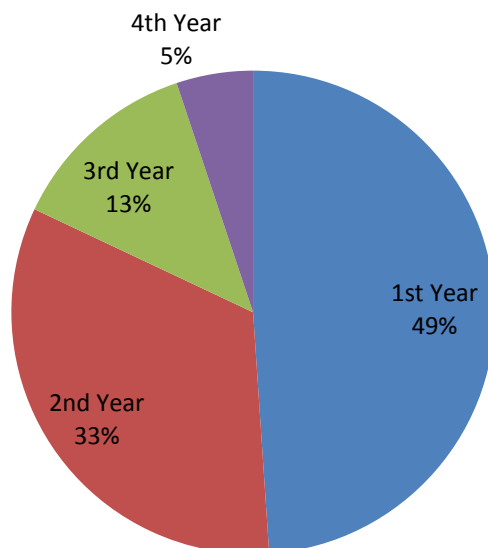
GTU during youth festival organises these two competitions and hence our motive was to motivate more and more students can participation in these events.

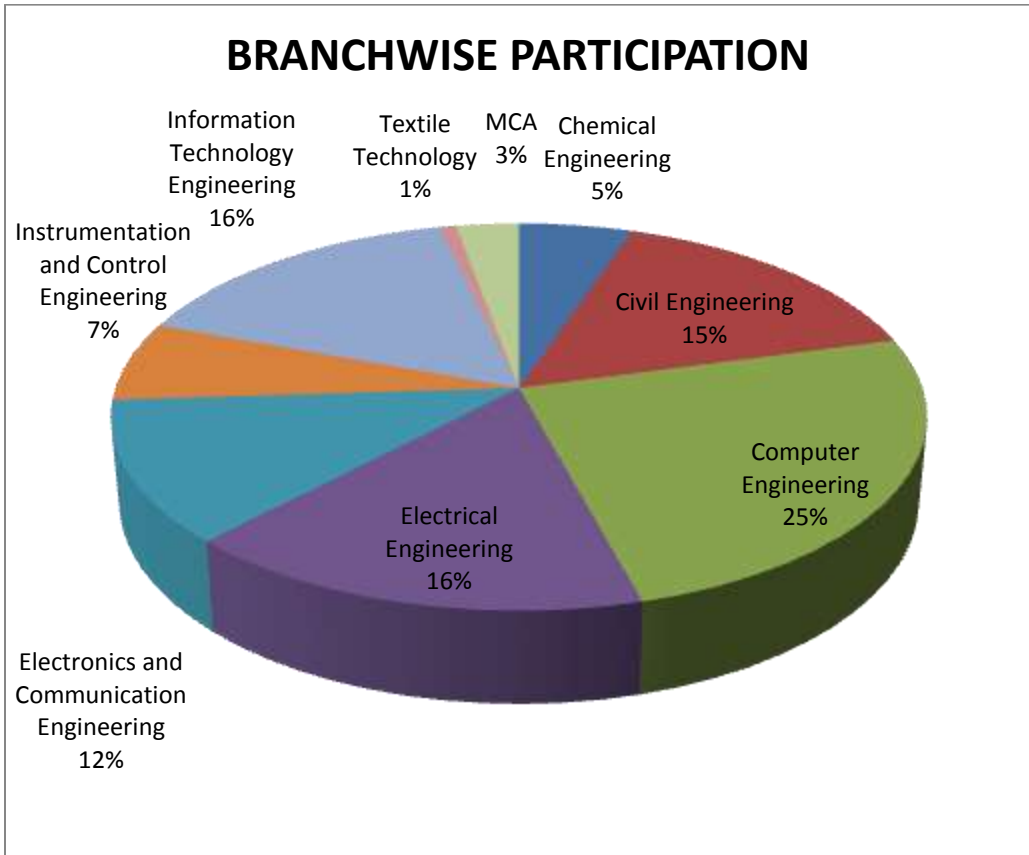
