Blood Stem Cells , derived from peripheral blood of the donor, have the capacity to replace the recipient's abnormal stem cells with healthy ones correcting the problem at the root-level. The blood stem cell transplant can be done to treat many fatal blood disorders such as Leukemia, Thalassemia and Aplastic Anaemia.

Under the guidance of Principal madam Dr. Vaishali Mungurwadi, the NSS unit of SCET had organized a *“Blood Stem Cell Awareness and Donor Registration Camp” in SCET from 19th September to 22nd September 2016* in association with **DATRI(NGO)**. He turned out to be the 1 in 10000 match for a small baby with severe blood disorder. When DATRI reached out to him, he was very positive. He immediately agreed to donate his blood stem cell to save the life .Our college along with entire NSS unit felicitated **SARTHAK** for his noble work.
